CHICAGO, July 14 (AP)—A late flurry of selling, starting in soybeans and spreading to other crops, left commodities with a weak look at the close on the board of trade today. Wheat closed 1/4-1/2 lower, corn was 1/2 lower to 3/4 higher, oats were 1/4-1/2 lower, rye was 1/4 to 1/2 lower, soybeans were 1 1/4-1/2 lower and active. Lard deliveries were unchanged to 3 cents a hundred pounds lower.
