UNIONVALE—Harvest of more than 200 acres of snap beans will begin Wednesday at the Alderman farms with a crew of about 300 pickers. W. J. Maxwell estimates that more than 1500 pickers will be employed by the farms before the expected 2,000 tons of beans are harvested.
