**Summer Rally Retarded in Stock Market**

NEW YORK, July 27-(AP)-A summer rally in the stock market stalled today. At the close of trading, the price level, after jiggling up and down all day, was just about where it was at the opening. Yesterday the market closed at the highest level since May 19, as measured by the Associated Press average of 60 stocks. It was the most recent gain in an advance that has been under way since mid-June. Trading was lively much of the day with business boosted by substantial dealings in Commonwealth & Southern. **Grains Back on Upward Trail**

CHICAGO, July 27-(AP)-Grains got back on the upward trail today. A little bit of the pessimism which was so pronounced yesterday carried over into today's early trade, but as the day wore on this attitude disappeared. Everything was sunny again at the close. The advance started first in corn, spread to soybeans, and finally even wheat joined the upward movement. All soybean contracts set new seasonal highs, but grains could not match previous high marks. Even lar showed signs of bullish life in response to army buying of cash lar. Wheat closed 1 to 1 1/2 higher, corn was 1/4-1/2 higher, oats were 3/4-1/2 higher, rye was 2 1/2-3 1/2 higher, soybeans were 4 to 5 cents higher and lar was 12 to

15 cents a hundred pounds higher.
