# Survey Shows Percentage of Church Members Jump in U. S.

NEW YORK, July 27 - More Americans - better than one out of every two - are church members now than at any time in history, according to the Yearbook of American Churches published this week.

Pointing out that 150 years ago only one person in five was a church member, Dr. Samuel McCrea Cavert, general secretary of the Federal Council of Churches, observed that the annual rate of increase, while behind earlier decades, is running slightly ahead of the country's population.

The number of diverse denominations, Dr. Cavert says, is not as serious as it looks. Ninety seven per cent of all church members are found on the rolls of the 50 largest denominations and eight denominational families embrace 80 per cent of all Protestants.
