

# Still Crucial; Beavers Play Oaks

## 3rd Placers At Portland

Some of the wind taken from their sails by virtue of Sunday's double loss to the Hollywood Stars, the Portland Beavers, now back in the second division of the Coast league baseball standings, open another crucial week at home Tuesday night. The Beavers play the third place Oakland Oaks who are now 3 1/2 games up on the fifth place Portland club. Oakland is 2 1/2 games behind second place Sacramento. At the same time Portland is 1 1/2 games up on the sixth place Seattle.

Other series this week place Hollywood at Seattle, San Diego at Los Angeles and Sacramento at San Francisco. Hollywood's 4-3 series conquest of the Beavers pushed the Stars 6 1/2 games ahead of second place Sacramento.

On the mound for Portland in Tuesday's opener will be either Roy Helser or Tommy Bridges.

The Portland-Hollywood series drew \$1,567 paid for the six days. Given a good start, against Oakland, the Beavers could do over 40,000 again this week.

## Grigger Sues 'Star' Fathers

CHICAGO, Aug. 1-(AP)—A former Notre Dame football player today sued for \$20,000 damages for injuries he said he suffered while training for a game in the 1948 Chicago "All-star" game.

William J. O'Connor, 25, of Tulsa, Okla., alleged in his federal court suit that the injuries had impaired his earnings by \$20,000. His attorney, John Paul Stevens, said O'Connor was unable to play for the Los Angeles Rams last year under an agreement through which he was to receive \$5,800. The player said he was injured in the chest during practice Aug. 14 and in the game between college stars and the Chicago Cardinals, National football league champions, on Aug. 20.

Defendants in the suit are the Chicago Tribune-New York News Syndicate, Inc.; the Chicago Tribune-News Service, Inc.; and Arch Ward, sports editor of the Chicago Tribune. The two corporations and Ward sponsor the annual game, Ward said in a statement that "Mr. O'Connor, like all other All-star players, was insured against loss of salary due to injuries in the All-star game or preparatory workouts by Lloyd's of London. The claim will be referred to the insurance company.

## Tahoe Entry Takes Trophy

DETROIT, Aug. 1-(AP)—A 30-foot California speedboat streaked around the Detroit River Harmsworth course today to capture the historic British International trophy for the Lake Tahoe, Calif., Yacht club.

R. Stanley Dollar's Skip-A-Long, with Dollar at the wheel, won the 16-mile run-off race with Jack Schaefer's Detroit boat, Such Crust. Both boats had won one heat in the successful defense of the Harmsworth trophy and the run-off was necessary to determine whether the Detroit trophy would remain in the Detroit Yacht club or go west.

Skip's best speed today was 88.821 miles per hour in the contested first lap.

## House Approves Stamp Increase

WASHINGTON, August 1-(AP)—Bills doubling the cost of the federal migratory bird hunting tax stamp and earmarking the excise tax on fishing equipment for use of the states for fisheries development were passed today by the house and sent to the senate.

The bird hunting bill, already passed by the senate but in different form, would increase the tax stamp cost from \$1 to \$2, with the extra revenue to be used for enforcement of bird hunting laws and the development of wildlife areas.

## Healy, Bevo Moguls to Talk Over Proposed Solon Purchase

William Healy, assistant secretary of state, said Monday he would confer with the Beaver baseball club management, probably Thursday or Friday in Portland, in connection with his proposal to purchase the George E. Waters baseball park here, along with the Salem Senators baseball team of the Western International league.

Healy indicated he and some associates were ready to purchase the Senators franchise, along with the ball park, provided the price was around \$60,000. The Salem baseball property is now being used as a farm by the Portland Beavers. Healy refused to divulge the names of his associates but said they mean business.

It was reported here that the Beaver management has fixed a price ranging from \$100,000 to \$125,000 for the Salem baseball park and franchise.

"If we purchase the property we desire to close the deal before the end of the current baseball season," Healy said. "That would place us in a position to complete reorganization before the opening of the 1950 baseball season."

A previous proposal to purchase the Salem baseball property locally fell through when the price asked by the Portland Beaver management was considered too high.

## Eriksen Said Syracuse Pick

SEATTLE, Aug. 1-(AP)—Unofficial but reliable sources said today Gus Eriksen, under whose tutelage freshmen crews at the University of Washington have never met defeat, has accepted the job of head crew coach at Syracuse university.

Eriksen was not available for comment, but friends said he has sold his home here and plans to leave for Syracuse in a few days.

Formal announcement of his acceptance is expected to come from Syracuse within the next 24 hours.
