Steel Industry Peace Gives Stocks Push

NEW YORK, Sept. 12-(AP)—The stock market took a big stride forward today in the midst of optimism over a steel industry labor-management dispute. Enthusiasm of the market was not dimmed by the fact that no announcement had been made before the exchange closed whether the CIO steelworkers had accepted or rejected the president's proposal for an extension of the strike truce expiring at midnight Tuesday. Stock prices advanced by fractions to more than a point generally throughout the list. The volume of trading hit 1,080,000 shares, the best since Aug. 18.

Grains Close Higher After Weak Opening

CHICAGO, Sept. 12-(AP)—Grains, soybeans and lard futures rallied today and put on a strong finish after a weak start. Late wheat buying was partly in sympathy with reports that the cash basis was firmer in most markets, especially in the east. Mills were reported buying wheat in Minneapolis also.

Wheat closed 1/4 to 3/4 higher than the previous finish, corn was up 1/4 to 1/2, soybeans were unchanged to 1/4 higher, rye was up 1/2 to 1 1/4, and lard was 7 to 20 cents a hundred pounds higher. Government purchases of cash wheat late last week in all positions totaled 476,000 bushels, including a fair amount through the Kansas City office. However, it was indicated that the same price as prevailed late last week would be paid for soft red winter wheat at Atlantic ports.
