It requires a cast of 2,000 people and animals. Next is "The Girl in the Moon," an aerial extravaganza with 60 smiling girls soaring in 60 smiling moons; then comes "San Francisco," dashing equestrian salute to the Golden Gate, the Gold Rush and the '49ers in this, their centennial year. Last is "The Glorious Fourth," the patriotic, aerial pageant, with elephants, clowns and girls in a red, white and blue tidal wave.
