BOSTON, Sept. 27 -(P)- Cries of "miracle men" hailing the Red of "miracle men" hailing the Red Garvais
Sox drive to the top of the American league today sounded like Aumsville
an echo to Boston fans 35 years away.

That's what they called George Stallings' Braves of 1914 when they came from last place - 101/2 games back on July 4 - to win the National league pennant.

And that's what they are calling Manager Joe McCarthy's Red Sox - even though they have yet to clinch the flag.

McCarthy's men were 12 games off the pace on the "Fourth"-the traditional date when baseball fans usually take stock and count

As long as the Sox kept above the .500 mark in wins and losses McCarthy kept up his optimism. "Shucks," he told a sports writer back in mid-summer, "what does dropping to sixth place mean at this stage of the race — or even seventh and eighth? It doesn't mean a thing, but what does mean something is the .500

"Never," reminded Joe, "go below the .500 mark."

The Red Sox did drop below the .500 mark in June - but only for a few games.

That's the gauge McCarthy used - and he told newsmen at the time of the all-star game in July that the Red Sox were ready.

At any rate, Boston fans have the world series fever. Even though the hub has had pennant winners in two of the last three years - Red Sox in 1946, Braves in 1948 - the fever is as bad




