

City Council Tightens Laws At Woodburn

WOODBURN — The city council struck out against youthful lawbreakers this week, passing a reckless driving law and demanding enforcement of the curfew ordinance.
The reckless driving ordinance, aimed against "squirrel driving" in the city, carries a fine ranging from \$15 to \$250 for violators.
The council also instructed police to arrest anyone under 17 years of age on city streets, parks or public places between 9:30 p.m. and sunrise unless accompanied by parents or when on emergency business. The ordinance also makes parents of offending youths liable and provides fines up to \$10.

Grain Prices Score Rise

CHICAGO, Oct. 6.—(AP)—A boost in the government wheat buying bid, coupled with wet weather throughout the mid-west, caused a run-up in grains on the board of trade today.
All sections of the market participated in the advance. Wheat closed 3/4-1 1/4 higher, corn was 1/2 higher, oats were unchanged to 1/4 higher, rye was 2 1/2-3 1/4 higher, soybeans were 1 1/4 to 2 cents higher and hard was 1/2 to 12 cents a hundred pounds higher.
Chief factor in wheat was an advance of 1/2 cent a bushel by the local CCC office for cash grain. It offered 11 cents over the December future for No. 2 soft red and No. 2 hard winter wheat delivered at Philadelphia.

Labor News Boosts Stocks

NEW YORK, Oct. 6.—(AP)—The stock market fattened today on persistent rumors that the steel and coal strikes will be quickly settled.
For the third day in a row, the general price level scored a new high for the year. Leading issues advanced fractions to a point or more.
Demand for some of the steels was notably aggressive. A handful of low-priced utilities also attracted large-scale buying and helped to swell the day's volume.
Trading was the most active in three weeks. Turnover of 1,520,000 shares compared with 1,470,000 yesterday. Large blocks of stock splashed all over the ticker tape.
The market was not a one-way affair. Aircraft stocks stumbled, for instance, along with radio and television issues, and some railway and utility shares.
