### Chinese Red Forces Said Near Kweilin

HONG KONG, Friday, Oct. 21 (AP)—Chinese communist troops today were believed near Kweilin, headquarters for Nationalist Gen. Pai Chung-Hsi's last-ditch defense in southwest China.

The hint came from an announcement that the China National Aviation Corp. was pulling out of Kweilin, capital of Kwangsi province 250 miles northwest of Canton.

A second red drive against Pai's 200,000 man army rolled up 160 miles southeast of Kweilin. The CNAC also pulled out personnel from Wuchow (Tsangwu), on the Kwangsi border there.

Press dispatches from the nationalist island fortress of Formosa said the nationalists intended to back up their sea blockade of Canton with air attacks.

The dispatches said that the first train crossing from this British crown colony into Chinese territory for Canton would be bombed.

They quoted the nationalist newspaper Chung Hwa Jih Pao as saying any communist hopes of using the overland route to obtain supplies from Hong Kong would be dashed by bombing.

### 'Quiet' Nuptials Heard by 400

WALLA WALLA, Oct. 20 (AP)—Nurse Victoria Penlick and Dr. W. A. Millington, both of the Walla Walla veterans hospital staff, were very careful to avoid all publicity concerning their wedding plans.

They so informed Chaplain Lawrence Cousins of the VA who was to perform the ceremony. Cousins agreed to keep the secret. The knot was tied shortly after Cousins finished a radio broadcast to the patients.

The Millingtons left on their wedding trip, unaware of their "bride and groom" broadcast.
