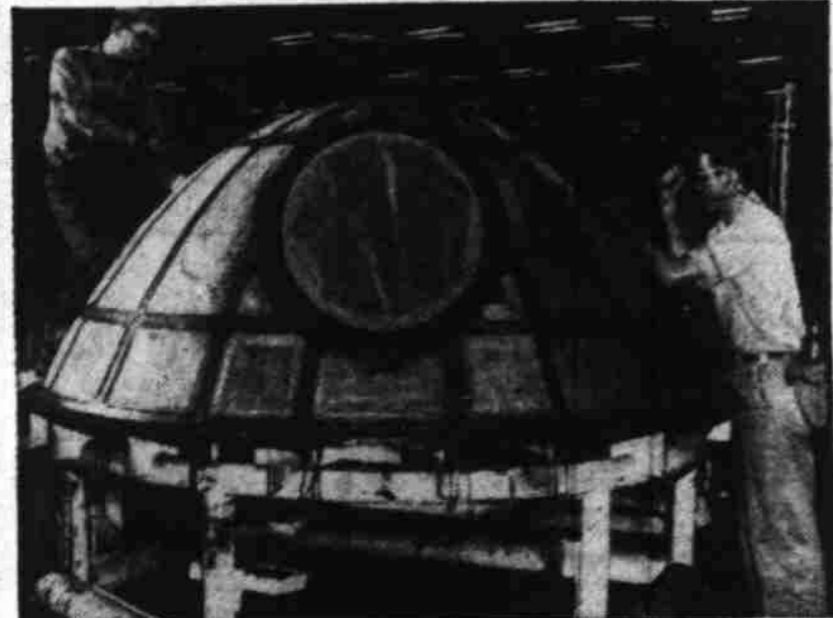


# BUILDING THE B-36

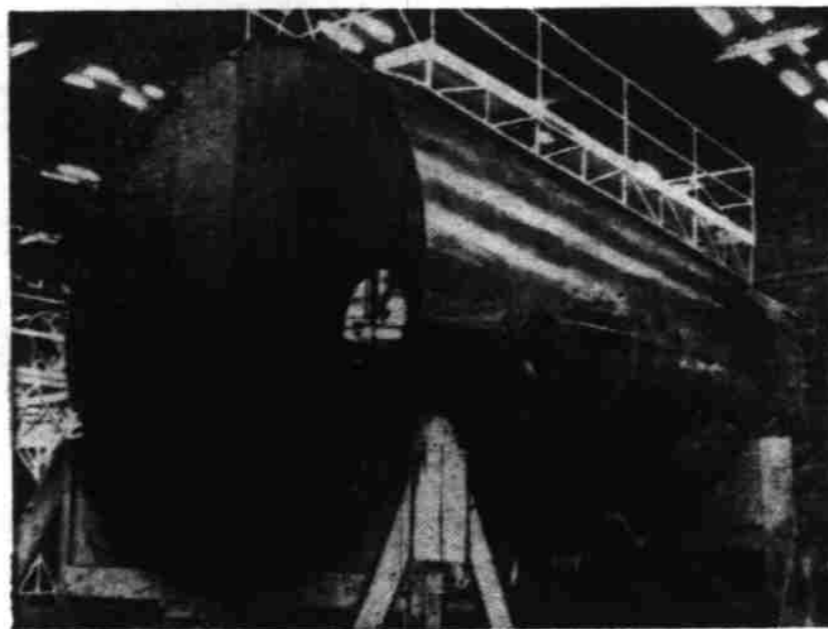


This is the plane described by the air force chief of staff as the "fastest, longest-range high altitude bomber in the world today," the plane that will be the backbone of America's aerial fleet "if we are unlucky enough to be forced into a war" four or five years now. It is the B-36 and the air force chief, Gen. Hoyt S. Vandenberg, says it will "fly over twice the height of the missions we flew in

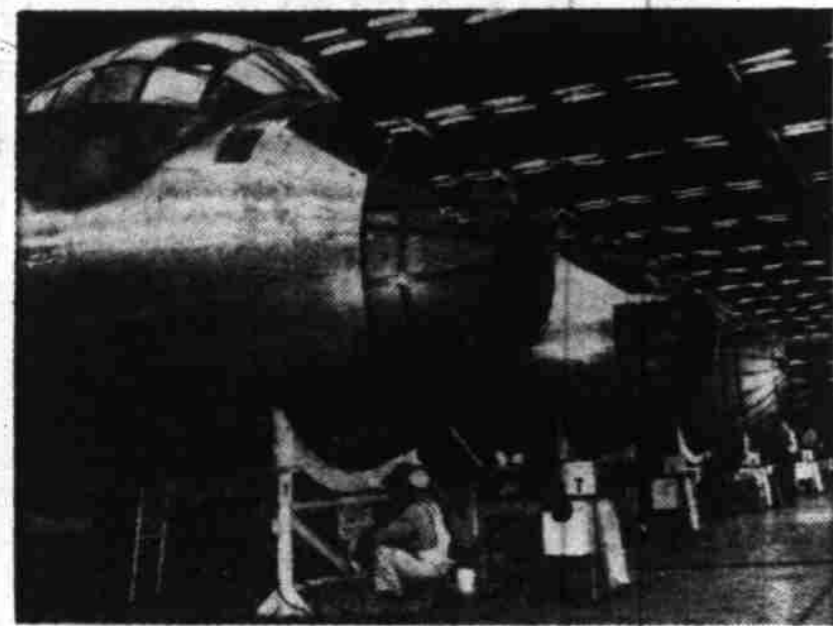
Europe and will go over twice as fast." Recently the air force stepped up orders for the six-engine, 150-ton heavy bombers and production was speeded at the Consolidated Vultee Aircraft corporation at Fort Worth. Here are some glimpses of the big bombers under construction.



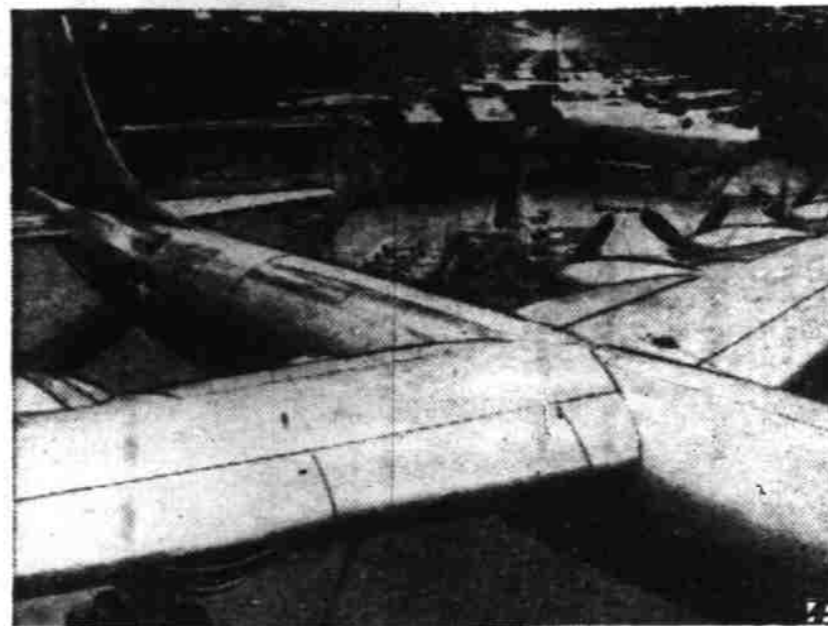
Bombardier's enclosure in last stages of glazing. Sealed during assembly, the enclosure is pressure tight after installation.

## This Is Strictly For the Birds

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo.—(INS)—Fast driving automobile owners have nothing on most game birds, according to authorities.

The following estimates are judged by authorities to be fairly accurate:

- Doves—40 miles per hour.
- Quail, prairie chicken, ruffed grouse, mallard, blackduck, spoon-bill, pintail, wood duck—50 M.P.H.
- Canada geese, and brant—45 M.P.H.
- Redhead—42 M.P.H.
- Green-wing teal—79 M.P.H.
- Blue-wing teal—89 M.P.H.
- Canvasback—72 M.P.H.

These are normal speeds. Authorities have not been able to determine how fast the birds can fly when frightened.

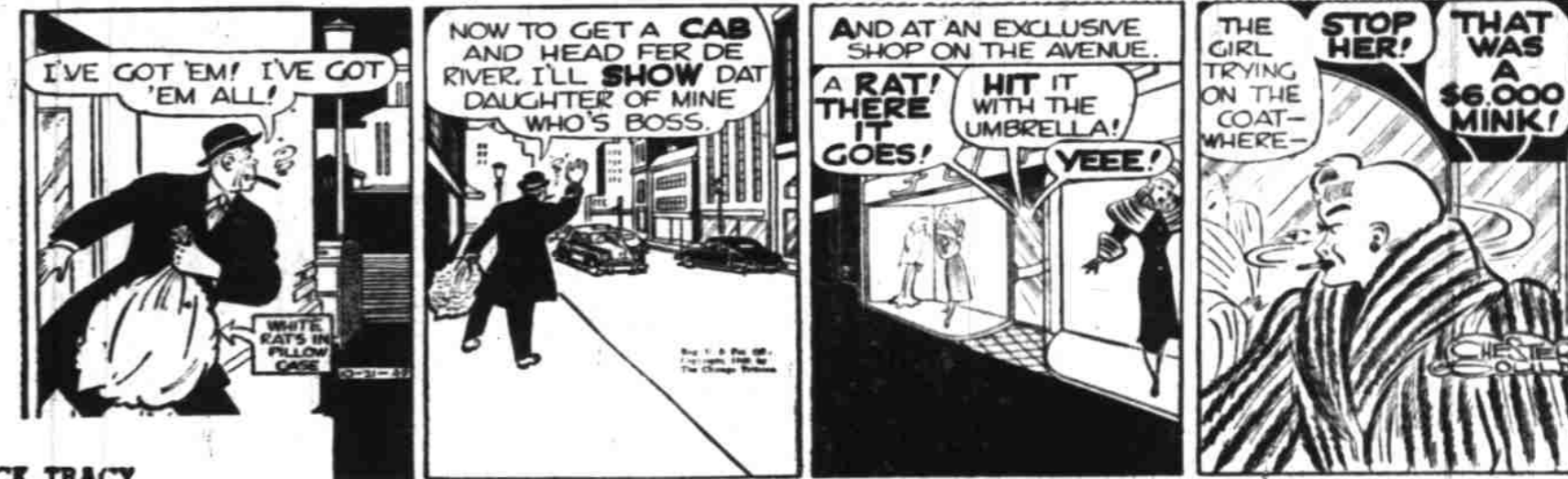

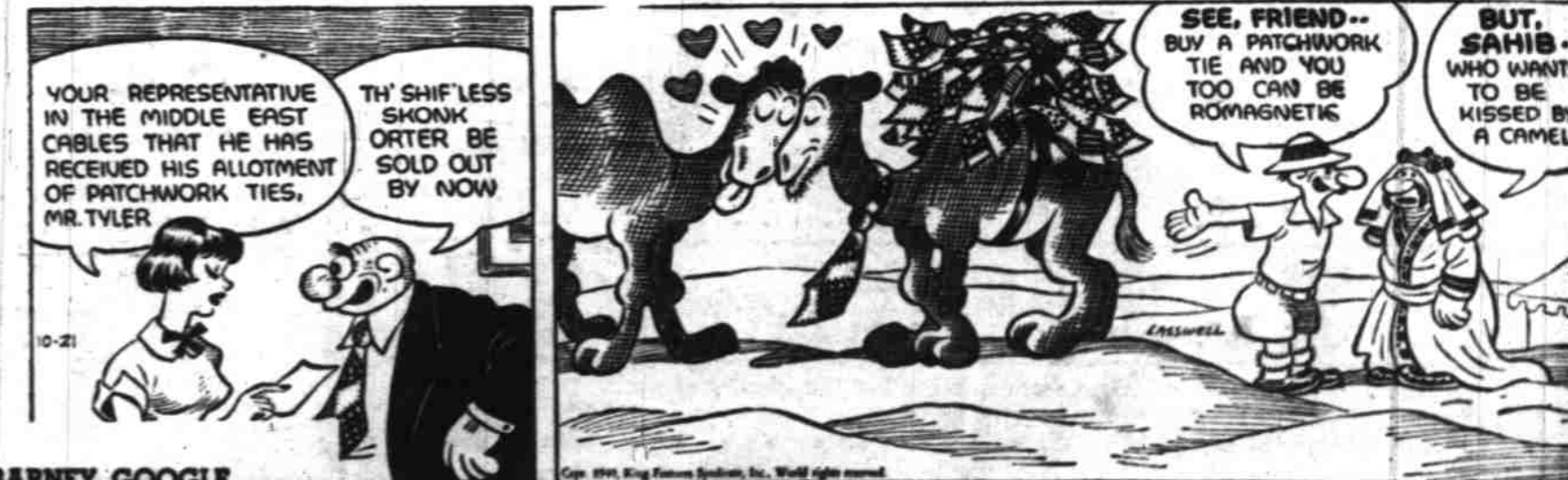
