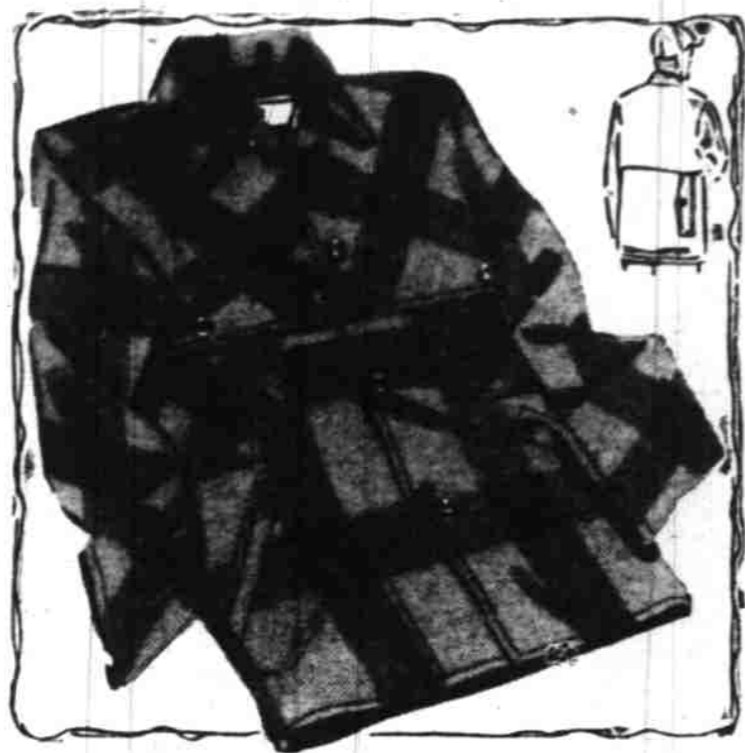
Osce Cook won the day's prize, birthday gifts were distributed and refreshments were served. The November meeting will be with Carrie Crawford.

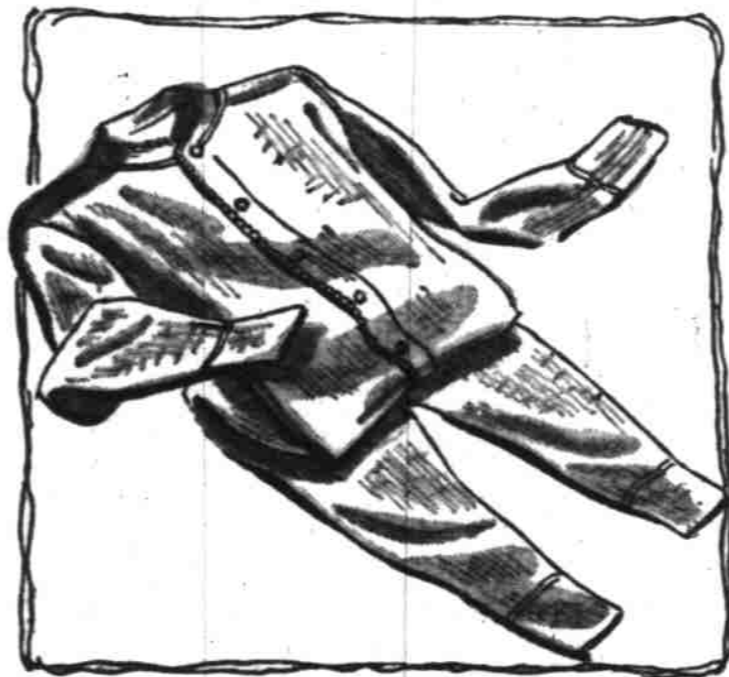
