

Gardening Today

For the new look in roses next summer, wise gardeners are making plans to include the four strikingly beautiful 1950 All-American rose selections in their plantings. The current holders of the horticultural "Oscar" include three hybrid teas, Capistrano, Mission Bells and Sutter's Gold, and the Lillie L. Madsen new floribunda Fashion.

Plants are scored on such characteristics as hardiness, vigor, fragrance, length of flower period, number of blooms and other important qualities by impartial judges.

Capistrano produces large rose pink buds, with open flowers sometimes measuring as much as six inches across. Mission Bells is a free-flowering hybrid tea of deep salmon pink. Sutter's Gold, a fragrant yellow, commemorates the 100th anniversary of the discovery of gold in California. Fashion, the only floribunda to win

the award, is a coral pink with a gold sheen.

Gardeners may obtain these new varieties from some nurseries but should submit their orders early as the winners are in heavy demand. Nice days from now to late February or early March—if the ground isn't soggy and sticky—should be rose planting time in the Willamette valley.

Holly Studies Made

Holly investigations at the Oregon State college agricultural experiment station have been enlarged into a separate horticultural project in an attempt to further the development of this increasingly important specialty crop to Oregon.

Last year, Oregon produced nearly two thirds of the nation's English holly, which is recognized as the top quality type in the trade. There are approximately 1,100 acres of holly planted in the state with some 400 acres in production. The estimated return to Oregon growers last year was more than \$200,000.

Objects of the new project center around finding the best varieties for commercial production, determining the best cutting and pruning practices, checking pollination needs and methods, and continuing studies in handling and storage.

More than 60 varieties have been gathered by the project workers at the state college and planted at the station horticulture farm as part of the testing and selection program, and more added each year.

C. B. asks if the strawberry tree will grow in this area, and what type of fruit does it have.

Ans.:—Yes, I have seen a num-

ber of strawberry trees (arbutus Unedo) in this area. There is one in the Union Hill district north of Sublimity that has lived a number of years. The foliage is evergreen and the berries, when fully ripe, are red. They are more of an orange for quite a time before they really turn red.

M. P. asks what magnolia she can grow in a small garden. Says she'd like one of the evergreen trees with the large white flowers but wonders if this doesn't grow quite large.

Ans.: For the small garden the M. Stolata, the small white, flushed with pink, variety is the best.

It grows about six feet high and branches shrub-like. It is very hardy and blooms almost from the beginning. Early March is believed the best time to set this one out. Almost all valley nurseries carry it. The large evergreen ones are not suitable in a small garden. They resent crowding and look out of place. Where space permits, they are beautiful.

G. O. asks if the oleander tree will grow out of doors here. Says hers is growing in a tub and that she brought it up from San Jose, Calif.

Ans.: No, the oleander will not as a rule, withstand our winter
