

## Truman Joins Administration Attack on Taft

WASHINGTON, Jan. 12 (AP)—President Truman today joined in an administration attack on a republican stalwart up for reelection this year: Senator Taft of Ohio.

Mr. Truman, commenting on Taft's demand for military aid to the Chinese nationalists, questioned Taft's ability as a military expert. And a bit later, he indicated he is getting rosy political reports from Ohio, where democrats are seeking to unseat Taft next year.

As for coal, the president said no national emergency exists at the present time. This means that, at least for the present, Mr. Truman doesn't intend to use the Taft-Hartley act in an attempt to get the miners back on a five-day week.

As for Taft—His name first came up when a reporter asked Mr. Truman about Taft's criticisms of the administration's policy in Formosa. The administration has refused to help the Chinese nationalists hold Formosa against the communists. Entitled to Opinion

Well, said the president, Senator Taft is entitled to his own opinions. But, the president added, he didn't know that Senator Taft was a military expert.

A little later Mr. Truman was asked about a report made to him by Democratic National Chairman William Boyle. This report dealt with politics in Ohio. The report was very satisfactory — from a democratic standpoint, the president said.

Had Boyle predicted Taft's defeat?

No Personalities

We didn't go into personalities, the president said.

Oddly: However they may differ politically, Mr. Truman repeatedly has mentioned the personal esteem in which he holds Taft. During one trip through Ohio he made a special aside to tell the voters that, as a man, he likes Taft fine.

Others besides Taft have attacked the Formosa policy, but Mr. Truman repeated today that the policy he laid down on a statement was thorough and complete.

The president said on another subject — he hopes to have his tax program ready by next week. Until then, no comment.

## Hospital Board Airs Plans for Improvements

Plans for future improvements at Salem Memorial hospital were discussed Thursday night at the annual meeting of the institution's board of directors.

While no action was taken, members spoke of establishing a psychiatric ward, installing a new elevator and remodeling a part of the building which was not included in the 1949 program. Some of the projects may be started this year.

Ford Watkins presented a check for \$15,900 to the board as final payment of \$100,000 Memorial hospital received from last year's Salem Hospital Development fund drive. Watkins was chairman of the money-raising campaign.

C. Ronald Hukins and Arthur Erickson were elected to the hospital board of directors for three-year terms. Re-elected to similar terms were A. C. Haag and William Beaver.

The following officers were re-elected: President Mal B. Rudd; vice president, Loyal Warner; secretary-treasurer, Charles Heitzel.

## Greyhound Express Rate Boost Okehed

Increased rates on express shipments by Pacific Greyhound lines were authorized Thursday by George H. Flagg, state public utilities commissioner.

The order was issued after study of testimony given by the bus company at a hearing December 19. The company has petitioned for the increase.

The commission ruled that the volume of express now being handled places hardship on passenger service and that present express rates do not produce enough revenue to be self-sustaining and are not compensatory for service rendered.

The bus company was ordered to file new rates with the commission within 10 days.
