

Marion County Gets \$109,473 In Road Funds

Marion county will receive \$109,473 in state highway funds and \$1,159 in state amusement tax revenues, according to figures by Secretary of State Earl T. Newbry.

Highway funds available for distribution throughout the state totaled \$1,709,708, while amusement revenues totaled \$45,999.

Distribution of highway funds is based on the number of motor vehicles registered in each county during the preceding year. Amusement taxes are apportioned on the basis of money expended by each county for old age assistance.

Other county totals in distribution of highway funds included Clackamas, \$89,310; Linn, \$63,581; Polk, \$29,064; and Yamhill, \$42,998.

Totals received in amusement tax revenues were: Clackamas, \$1,046; Linn, \$436; Polk, \$322; and Yamhill, \$324.

Marion county received the second largest total of amusement tax revenues in the state and the third largest apportionment of funds.

Parent-Nurse Conference Set At Woodburn

pointment), and child guidance clinic at department office, (by appointment).

Thursday — Immunization, Hubbard school, 9 a.m. to noon, and child health conference at department (by appointment), 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.

Friday — Clinic for adults, food and milk handlers, beauty operators, tuberculin testing, blood tests and immunizations, 9 to 11:30 a.m. and 2 to 4 p.m.

Saturday — Immunizations for children and adults at the health department, 9 to 11:30 a.m.

Most Oregon School Buses Pass Inspection

Most of the 1,252 school buses inspected in Oregon since last August were found to be safe, Secretary of State Earl T. Newbry said Saturday.

As directed by the 1949 legislature, Newbry hired two inspectors to check every school bus. The first inspection now is complete. Prior to last year, inspection was in charge of the public utilities commission.

A few buses were found to be obsolete, and they have been replaced.

Clackamas county has the most buses, 108. Lane county has 106. Gilliam county has the fewest, four.

The safety division of Newbry's office has given courses of instruction to 1,000 school bus drivers.
