

Upsets Mark Court Week

St. John's, Kentucky
Bradley, LIU Lose

NEW YORK, Jan. 22 (AP)—Reading, writing and arithmetic instead of dribble, shoot and pass, remains the essence of attention for most of the nation's college basketball teams this week.

Most of the boys have been cramming and taking their semester examinations for over a week and it will be at least another seven days before the hoopsters swing into high gear again.

Despite the lack of frenzied activity a number of upsets were scored that may cause some changes in the ranks of the nation's top ten.

Holy Cross' top seeded five ran its victory string to 14 without a loss but St. John's, 1, long Island U., Bradley and Kentucky, second, third, fourth and fifth ranked respectively in the Associated Press' poll suffered defeats.

De Paul turned back St. John's and North Carolina State floored LIU, Thursday while Detroit slugged down Bradley, 67-54, Saturday night and Georgia thumped Kentucky last Tuesday.

Kentucky, however, rebounded with a crushing 86-53 victory over De Paul, St. John's conquerors, Saturday to remain very much in the running for national honors.

Duquesne, C.C.N.Y., Indiana, U.C.L.A. and LaSalle, who round out the top ten in that order, solidified their holds. C.C.N.Y. and U.C.L.A. were idle while Duquesne scored a triumph to run its spotless record to 14 triumphs. Indiana also posted one victory while LaSalle racked up two. LaSalle's 11th triumph against only two losses was a 74-53 verdict over St. Joseph's Saturday.

Illinois, defending Big Ten champions, dealt Ohio State's hopes of crashing the top ten a staggering blow with a 66-50 victory last night. The Buckeyes were ranked 11th. The loss also dumped Ohio State into a first place tie with Wisconsin for the Big Ten lead.

Tampa Open Won by Riley

TAMPA, Fla., Jan. 22 (AP)—Polly Riley, Fort Worth amateur, whipped the cream of the country's lady professionals to win the Tampa Women's Open Golf tournament by five strokes today.

Miss Riley came through with a final round 76 for a 72-hole total of 295.

Louise Suggs, women's open champion, shooting 73 today, wound up with an even 300 for second place. As top pro the little Georgian took first money of \$1,000 in the \$3,500 event.

Marlene Bauer, 15-year-old woman athlete of 1949, tied pro Betty Jameson at 302 for third place. Miss Bauer, from Midland, Tex., shot 74 today.

Miss Jameson, from San Antonio, had a 73. Her second place among the pros paid \$775.

Two strokes back at 304 was Babe Zaharias, with a 76 for the final 18. She won \$650.

It was a well deserved victory for Miss Riley, who came back from first round bad luck to out-steady the veteran pros. She started out with a blazing 33 for the first nine and was on her way to a possible record round until she took eight on the par five 18th hole.

That gave her 72, second to Mrs. Zaharias' first round 70. Par on the 6,000-yard Palma Celia course is 70 for men, 75 for women.

Miss Riley went into the lead to stay the following day, shooting 74 as the Babe blew to an 82.

Marjorie Lindsay of Decatur, Ill., was another amateur with a fine comeback. Her 72 brought a total of 311 and a tie with Betty MacKinnon, Dallas, and Edean Anderson of Helena, Mont. Miss MacKinnon took 77 today; Miss Anderson, 76.

Rome Invites 1960 Olympics

LONDON, Jan. 22 (AP)—Rome has put in a bid for the 1960 Olympic games, the official bulletin of the International Olympic committee reported here.

The bulletin said three other cities previously had extended invitations. They are Los Angeles, Calif., Buenos Aires, Argentina, and Lausanne, Switzerland.

The next summer Olympics will be staged at Helsinki, Finland, in 1952 and the next winter Olympics at Oslo the same year. The 1956 games have been awarded to Melbourne, Australia (summer) and Cortina d'Ampezzo, Italy (winter).

Charles-Beshore Title Mix Nearer

BUFFALO, N.Y., Jan. 21 (AP)—Matchmaker Charlie Pinto of the Fairview Athletic club said today negotiations for an Ezzard Charles-Freddie Beshore heavyweight title fight here Feb. 28 are in progress.

Pinto said he hoped to complete arrangements next week for the 15-round go in Memorial auditorium.

The deal offered Charles is 37½ per cent of the net. The gross could run around \$70,000, with tickets scaled from \$4 to \$20.

Norwegians Top Ski Meet

BERLIN, N.H., Jan. 22 (AP)—George Thrane of Norway and Hans Kaarstein, Norwegian exchange student at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, tied for first place today in the national jumping championship on the Nansen Ski club's 80 meter hill.

The combined winner, however, of the two-day event which began with the 11-mile national cross-country event yesterday was Gordon Wren of Steamboat Springs, Colo.

Kaarstein, who won the jumping event here in 1948 and was the North American champion the same year in the event held here, had leaps of 212 and 223 feet. Thrane had leaps of 212 and 220 feet.

Wren had jumps of 205 and 213 feet. In the class "A," country yesterday he was 13th, with a time of one hour, three minutes and 57 seconds.

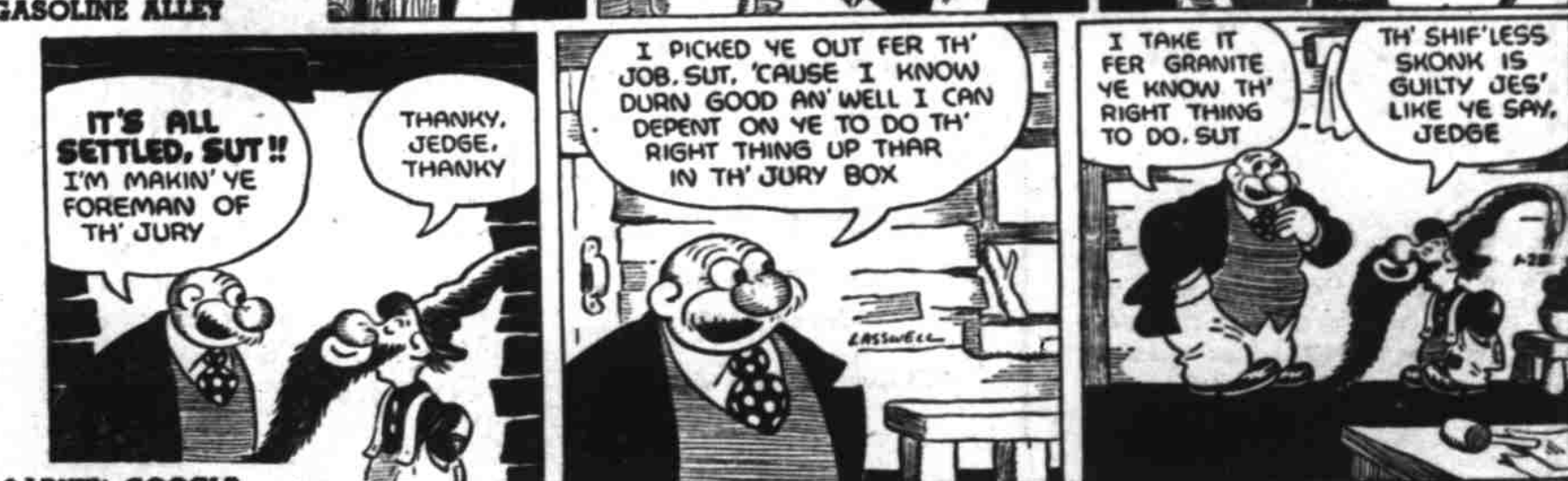
