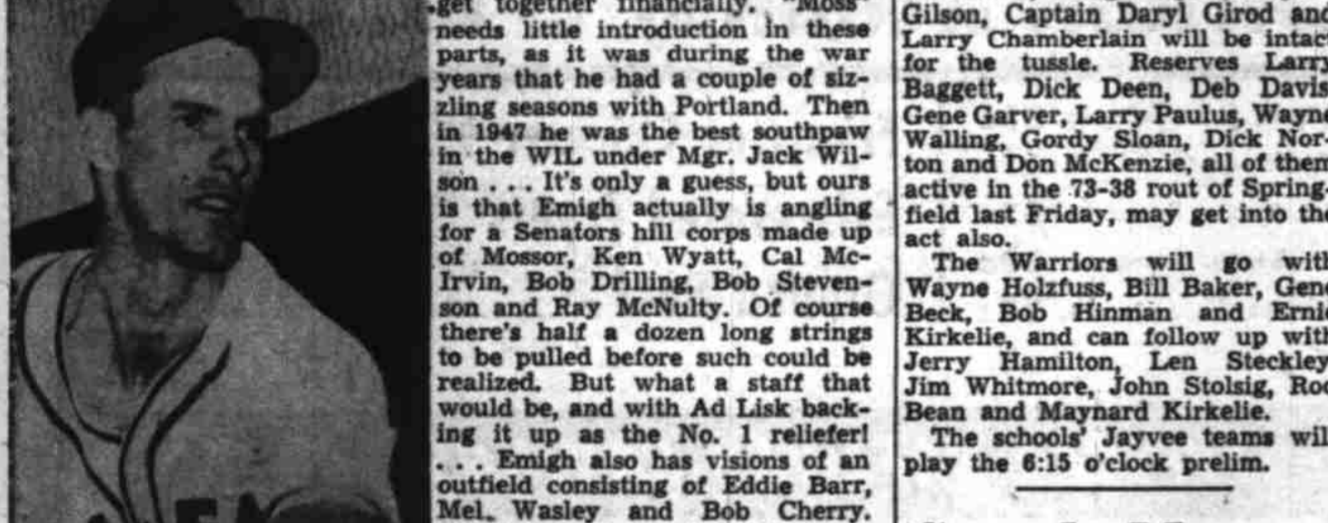
Vikings, Lebanon Clash In Mix at Villa Tonight
