Grain Market Contracts End Session Low

CHICAGO, Feb. 20.—(AP)—Most grain contracts ended a little lower today after a session of listless dealings.

Exceptions to the general trend were new crop wheat deliveries and the March soybean contract.

Wheat ended 1/4 lower to 3/4 higher, corn was unchanged to 1/4 lower, rye was 1/4 lower.

The March wheat contract reached \$2.21 at one time, a new peak on the current advance and less than 1 cent under the seasonal high.

Failure of the advance in March to hold was attributed partly to profit-taking as this contract has had a good gain over the past few weeks.

Stocks of wheat and grain in store at Chicago this week total 6,820,000 bushels, down from 7,485,000 in the preceding week.
