

Ingrid Due in U.S. to Fight For Daughter

LOS ANGELES, March 16-(AP)—Ingrid Bergman will return to the United States to fight personally for custody of her 13-year-old daughter, Pia Lindstrom, the actress' attorney said tonight.

But counsel for her husband, Dr. Peter Lindstrom, indicated a hot contest is in store. He said the surgeon will counter with the charge that Miss Bergman is not a proper person to have custody.

"Ingrid is determined to make the fight of her life for Pia," said her chief attorney, Gregson Bautzer. "She will be a witness when

the case comes to trial." Bautzer said Miss Bergman will leave Italy "as soon as the trial date is set."

Dr. Lindstrom's lawyer, Isaac Pach, said that the husband soon will file an answer to Miss Bergman's suit demanding custody of Pia and an accounting of the couple's community property. Pach said a full inventory will be given, and added:

"And we are certainly going to assert that Miss Bergman is not a proper person to have custody of this child. We will show that Dr. Lindstrom, by his action and conduct in this matter, is the proper person to have the child."

Pach talked to reporters, in Dr. Lindstrom's presence, about the suit filed yesterday by Miss Bergman's counsel in which she demanded \$154,000 in assets she says are held by the doctor, and custody of Pia. Pach said the surgeon will himself ask for a California divorce, disregarding Miss Bergman's recent Mexican divorce.

Youth Shot While Fleeing In Stolen Car

A youth who was shot as he fled from a stolen car in north Salem Wednesday night was apprehended by state police yesterday along with eight other teenagers who were charged with theft of the auto.

The boy, a 16-year-old, was treated for a thigh wound which police said was not considered serious. Then he joined seven others who are awaiting court action in juvenile detention quarters.

Three of those nabbed were listed as students or former students at Chemawa school. Several were listed as residents of Toppenish, Wash.

The only non-juvenile was arraigned in district court on a larceny charge and is to enter a plea today. She was booked as Juanita Hodge, 19, Wapato, Wash.

The girls were not in the car when a state policeman tried to stop it because of a burned-out headlight. The youths sped away, then abandoned the car and ran as the patrolman fired shots after them.

Oleomargarine Tax Repeal Aids Soybeans

CHICAGO, March 16-(AP)—Old crop soybean contracts celebrated presidential signing of the oleomargarine tax repeal measure by pushing up to new highs today.

Selling toward the close knocked as much as a cent off the top of the bean price advance, but still left March, May and July with fair-sized gains. The March contract, bringing \$2.52 1/2 at one time, sold at the highest point for any bean delivery since July, 1948.

The rest of the market, weak early, followed soybeans higher in the afternoon trade.

16-Year-Old Salem Girl Admits Theft

A Christmas Eve car prowling landed a 16-year-old Salem girl in detention quarters here Thursday.

She was the eighth teen-ager arrested this week by the city juvenile officer in a case that was touched off last Monday when two youths were nabbed after they attempted a burglary.

Their statements started a chain-reaction which has resulted in new arrests every day this week. All of the youths are charged with burglaries, thefts or both.

Police said the girl admitted receiving \$17.50 as her cut of \$70 which was taken from a car parked in Salem the night of Dec. 24, 1949.

Then, detectives said, she and several boys drove to Silverton and prowled cars, stealing a watch, binoculars, whisky and beer. She told police they threw the binoculars away.

According to police, the girl has been consistently truant from school, was picked up for curfew violation last month, is considered incorrigible at home, and admits

being arrested for reckless driving in Stayton, for speeding in McMinnville and Brownsville and for minor traffic violations on other occasions.

Bjorke Given Silverton City Hall Project

SILVERTON, March 16—C. M. Bjorke, Silverton contractor, tonight was awarded a \$7,027 contract for an addition to the city hall at a city council meeting.

Bjorke indicated work on the two-story addition would begin next week. The job must be completed within 60 days.

An application by Ted Burian for a zone change on east hill was referred by the council to the planning commission. Burian wants to construct a larger building for his grocery store and to turn the present store site into a parking lot.

An ordinance which would double sewer rates in Silverton was given a second reading. One more reading will be required before the law will be enforceable.

Leopold to Await Verdict

GENEVA, Switzerland, March 16-(AP)—Leopold III, exiled king of the Belgians, interpreted the Sunday referendum of his people as a call to duty and asked Belgium's parliament today to make him king in fact or declare he should abdicate.

"Whatever the decision... I will be bound by it," Leopold said. "The national will has been clearly expressed. Under the circumstances, I can not do other than to remain at the disposition of the nation."
