

The Bible Story - - - ISAIAH

The spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to reclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to comfort all that mourn; to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

There shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse; and the spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, and shall make him of quiet understanding in the fear of the Lord. With righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth. And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the falling together; and a little child shall lead them. For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea. And that root of Jesse shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. Say to them of fearful heart, Fear not: your God will come and save you. Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then shall the lame leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Behold, the Lord God will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him. He shall feed his flock like a shepherd; he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.

The everlasting God fainteth not, neither is weary: there is no searching of his understanding. He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. They that wait upon the Lord shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.
