

More Favorites Tumbled From Mid-Willamette Golf Tourney

Yost-Carson Go Postponed

Sederstrom, Mapes, Schafer Eliminated

More of the favorites were humbled Sunday at the Salem Golf course as the second round of the Elks-sponsored Mid-Willamette Valley tournament went on the cards.

Jack Owens, playing the same type of golf with which he dispatched Win Needham in the opening round, rolled past Schafer 2 and 1. Bob Powell turned Ray Clark by a like score to move into the quarter final round against Owens.

Jack Russell, a 1949 semi-finalist, gained the third round Sunday by coming from behind to eliminate Bob Sederstrom 2 and 1. Russell, troubled a little by erratic irons, toured the course in an even par 72 while his opponent took a 74. Harold Olinger clung to a first-nine margin to drop Ralph Mapes from the tourney by a 1-up count. Olinger fired a 74 and Mapes a 75.

In the lower bracket of the championship flight Bob Burrell, Jack Brande and Jim Hunt moved into the quarter-finals, each on 2-2 victories over Ron Hoxie, Bob Albright and Harv Quistad, respectively. They will be joined Tuesday by the winner of the Dick Yost-Carson second round match. Yost, defending champion, was unable to sandwich a Sunday match into his active college schedule.

Win Needham, John Graham, Lawrence Alley, Roger Putnam, Dale Arehart, Ned Ingram and Floyd Baxter all gained victories in first flight competition. Graham gained his third round notch by eliminating Jim Sheldon, who was figured earlier to be a strong contender for championship honors.

All second round losers were automatically eliminated from the tournament. Third round cards are to be completed by next Sunday night.

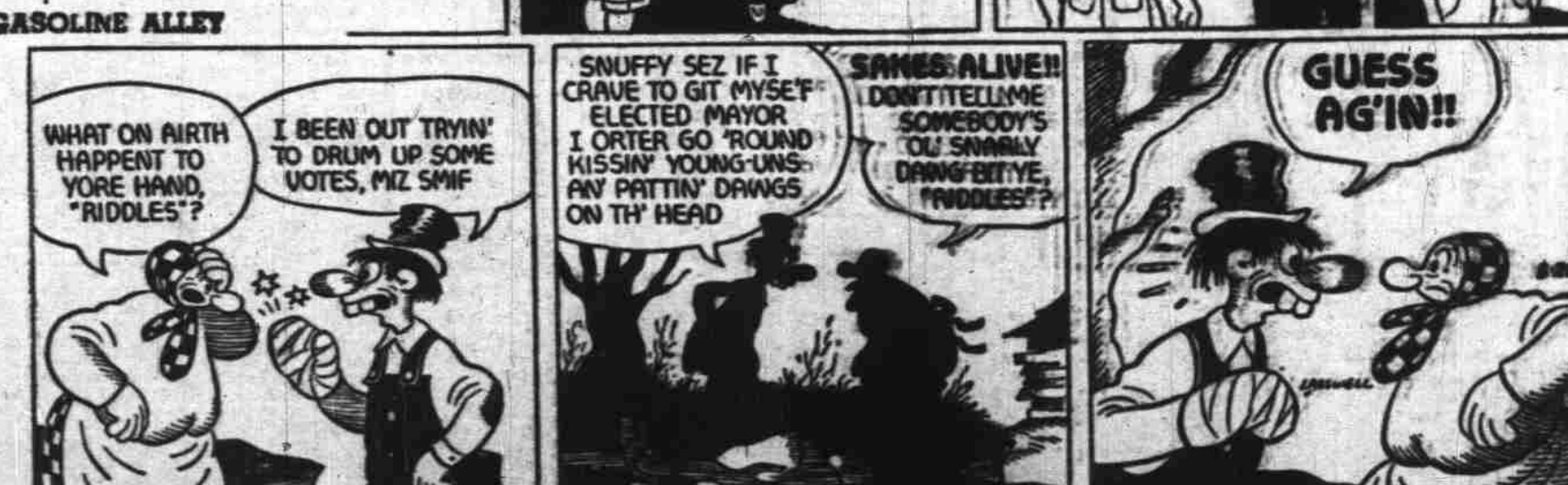
