Feed Grains Stay High in Weak Market

CHICAGO, June 5 (AP) — The two major feed grains, corn and oats, held up well in a generally weak market on the Board of Trade today. Everything else suffered a set-back.

Wheat ended 1½-1% lower, corn was ¾ lower to ¼ higher, oats were ¾ lower to ¼ higher, rye was ¾-1¼ lower, soybeans were ¾-1¼ lower and land was 7½ to 25 cents a hundred pounds lower.

Wheat met a constant dribble of hedging pressure all day. Harvesting will expand rapidly from now on, traders said, and producers may be inclined to see old crop grain in order to make room for the new. This is particularly true as prices are around the government support level, they added.

Mills were on the buying side of wheat on the way down, but not to a large extent to stem the slump. Buying was believed based on a production and marketing administration request for offers of 159,000 hundred pound sacks of flour for acceptance tomorrow.
