

### 3 Juveniles Admit Taking Two Bicycles

Three juveniles, ages 13, 14 and 15, were released to their parents Thursday after admitting to city police that they had stolen two bicycles from Leslie school June 2.

Two of the youths said they needed transportation to go swimming the last day of school. They said they hid the bicycles in the brush along Sheldon ditch and later reclaimed them. They said their parents were told the bicycles had been abandoned.

The third boy admitted to police that he knew the bicycle he had in his possession at the time of arrest Thursday had been stolen.

Juvenile authorities showed the boys the detention ward and warned them they would be jailed if they ever stole anything again. They were released to parents on promise that they would be punished at home.
