### Portland Soldier **Injured** in Combat


WASHINGTON, July 18 -(AP)-Six Americans were reported dead and 39 missing in two casualty lists from the Korean area made public by the defense department today.

## 6-Point Fight With Inflation Set by Eccles

SALT LAKE CITY, July 18-(AP)-Marriner S. Eccles of the federal reserve board said today dangerous inflation is developing rapidly because of the Korean crisis.

In a statement he proposed the inflation be checked through taxes, stricter credit control and reduction of civilian demand for

Eccles, a member of the federal eserve board of governors and former Utah banker, suggested this fiscal program for the govern-

1-Make no reduction in taxes this year.

2—Reimpose a corporation ex-cess profit tax of 75 per cent on all net earnings above 10 per cent of the first \$5,000,000 of invested capital and 8 per cent on any balance, allowing a \$5,000 exemption of earnings subject to tax.

3-Request organized labor to make no demands for wage increases while the excess profit tax

is in effect, 4-Close tax loopholes.

5-Increase second and third class postal rates enough to meet post office department deficits. 6-U. S. treasury to offer nonbank investors long term non-mar-ket bonds with 15-year maturity interest rate of 21/2 per cent.


