

Over Oregon

Portland, July 20—The Portland traction company today asked the city council for permission to increase bus fares from 12 to 15 cents, eliminate weekly passes and the sale of nine tokens for \$1, and increase student fares slightly.

Roseburg, July 20—A logging accident killed Roy Archer, 49, of Winston yesterday. He was employed by the Roseburg Lumber company in the Upper Olalla region.

Portland, July 20—Four new polio cases were reported in Oregon last week, the state board of health disclosed today. The cases in Josephine, Lane, Morrow and Multnomah counties, brought the year's total to 58, slightly below a year ago at this date.

LaGrande, July 20—Construction of concrete pipes for LaGrande's \$240,000 storm sewer project has been started here. About 45,000 feet of pipe of various sizes will be laid. The work will be financed by a bond issue authorized May 19.

Cottage Grove, Ore., July 20—A truck collision killed Robert Stanley Campbell, 20, of Cottage Grove, on the Black Butte highway two miles south of here yesterday. Both trucks were hauling logs.

Medford, July 20—A hurtling automobile killed a Portland man on the Crater Lake highway yesterday. Richard Hudnut, 45, died when his automobile struck a soft shoulder, rolled over twice and crashed against a tree. His wife, Fern, 29, was treated at a hospital for injuries.

Portland, July 20—The bureau of land management reported today it sold 14 million board feet of Oregon-California and public domain lands in July. The timber which brought \$145,224, is Douglas fir and pine in Clatsop, Crook, Deschutes, Jackson, Klamath and Lake counties in Oregon, and in Washington and Idaho.

Oakridge, July 20—This Cascade mountain logging community lost its sixth police chief in a year today. Fred R. Lailoux resigned, he said, to go into business elsewhere. At the same time, Vern Williams, himself a former police chief, resigned as superintendent of streets and water.
