ORDERED, that the findings and determinations of the Oregon State Game Commission adopted at its stated meeting held on January 13, 14, 27 and 28, 1950, respectively, fixing and determining the general open season for angling for sturgeon be and they hereby are modified by closing to angling for sturgeon the Willamette River above the Oregon City Falls, located in Clackamas County, Oregon.


