New County Health Man Announced

Wade Patterson, 29, of Portland, Wednesday was appointed health educator for the Marion county department of health, by Dr. Willard Stone, county health officer.

Patterson, University of Washington graduate, will take over his new duties October 1. He succeeds Howard Pyfer, who plans to study for a medical degree in Seattle. Pyfer had been filling the post of Francis Reiser, who was on leave to attend the University of California and since has been appointed to a post in the state health department.

Patterson, native of Portland, attended Oregon State college in 1940-42, University of Washington, 1946-48, graduating with degrees in health and physical education. He has taken graduate work in administration and supervision of education from the University of Oregon extension school. He taught school and coached all sports at St. Helens high school for the past two years.

He was a navy pharmacist's mate during the war. He served in the South Pacific and completed his tour of duty at Guam.

Patterson is in Salem this week familiarizing himself with his duties which, in general, consist of promoting health activities through organized community efforts.

Suspended Jail Sentence Given Check Writer

Murel Cluck, 2173 N. Front st., received a suspended 60-day jail sentence Wednesday in Marion county district court on a charge of drawing a bank check with insufficient funds.

Cluck previously had changed his plea from innocent to guilty to the charge. He was placed on probation for one year.

In other court action, Judge Joseph Felton authorized the release of Alfred Ecker, Monroe, to a U. S. marshal. Ecker, who admittedly was involved in a post-office holdup at Aurora in 1948, was wanted for violation of a federal parole.

Timber Tract Sale Slated For October 9

Four timber tracts in Polk and Clackamas counties will be put up for sale at an oral auction scheduled October 9 at the district forester's office in Salem.

The bureau of land management announced the timber included an estimated 6,000,000 board feet of lumber.

An additional 12,000,000 board feet located on two timber tracts in Benton county also is up for sale. Sealed bids will be opened October 10 in the office of the regional administrator in Portland.

Other oral auction sales of timber will be conducted between October 9 and 13 in Eugene, Roseburg, Medford and Coos Bay.

Coeds Enjoy 1 to 2 Ratio On Men at WU

The men-on-campus outnumber the coeds nearly 2 to 1 at Willamette university, registration figures showed Wednesday.

Of the 1,000 or so students here for the new Willamette term which opened this week, 990 had completed registration by yesterday. Additional registration is expected through this month.

Officials said 525 men and 285 women have registered in liberal arts, 27 men and 40 women in the college of music, 101 men and 2 women in the college of law. In the liberal arts junior class, men outnumber the coeds 135 to 43 for the highest class ratio.

Freshman figures show 251 in liberal arts, 41 in law and 18 in music. There are 33 graduate and special students included in the liberal arts total.

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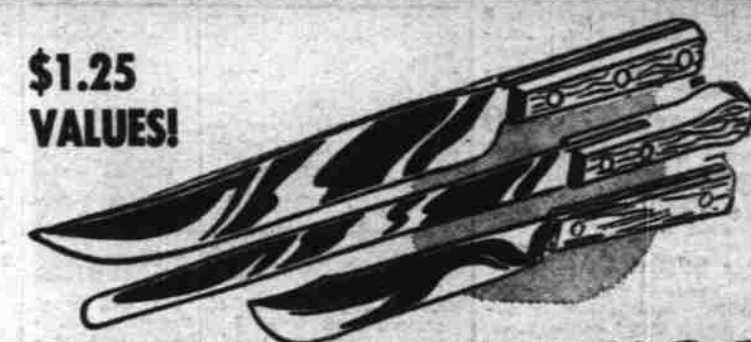
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
