CLEVELAND - (INS) - Many housewives who boast about their spotless kitchens may be surprised to find out that their pots and pans stay dirty even after being scrubbed.

Electric lighting laboratory in Cleveland are using "black light" to detect otherwise invisible food particles on cooking utensils, dinnerware and other kitchen equipment.

The invisible ultraviolet rays show that utensils may be dirty even though under normal lighting they appear to be fairly clean. The researchers take the pot to be examined and treat it with a non-toxic fluorescent dye. They then rinse the pot in clean water and examine it under "black light."

Food particles absorb the dye and fluoresce when exposed to the invisible radiation.

G. E. technicians point out that, although the equipment used is too elaborate for the home kitchen, the "black light" method is especially applicable to the work of health and sanitation departments.
