# **Dairy Co-op Studies Bulk Milk Tanks**

SILVERTON-Richard Barnes youngest director of the Oregon Dairy Co-op association, was one of the four-man committee to visit the Los Angeles dairy area last week to inspect new tanks for storage of bulk milk.

Grover Poe, in charge of the field department of the co-op; Sam Graham, head of the procurement department, and Erwin Laughlin, manager of the Western Dairy Equipment company, all of Portland, drove to Los Angeles earlier in the week and Barnes joined them by plane on Wednesday.

The area visited, one of the larger concentrated milk production centers in the world, uses the bulk tanks 100 per cent. Milk is poured directly into the bulk tanks, where cooling takes place. It is later transferred to the pickup bulk tanks.

The committee was told that the bacteria count dropped from 200,-000 to 40,000 per CC after the in-stallation of bulk tanks.

The average dairy farm is 10 acres with 200 cows the average herd. All feed is purchased and hauled into the area. The largest farm visited by the four, maintained 3,000 cows.

The committee, Barnes stated, will recommend to the association that Grade A milk producers affiliated with the association, be placed on a bulk tank delivery service as soon as feasible.

The bulk system has been under an intensive study in the Willam-ette valley for several weeks. While this committee, of which Barnes is a member, was on its tour in the south, other directors made a similar visit to the dairy around Linden, Wash., where the bulk tank system has been in use for over six months.


