

Losses Hold Edge on Gains In Stock Mart

NEW YORK, Oct. 8.—(AP)—Losses outnumbered the gains by a slight margin on the stock exchange today in an indecisive session. The pattern of mixed prices extended into every major group. Changes either way were fractions in most cases.

The volume hit 1,860,000 shares. The Associated Press averages didn't reflect a wholly true picture of the market as the figure for 60 stocks advanced 10 cents to \$101.30, a new 21-year high. The industrial and utility categories gained 10 cents each while rails remained unchanged.

Over the weekend Canada announced it would sell part of its gold production for non-monetary purposes in the world markets. Since Canadian markets were closed because of Thanksgiving day in the dominion, it was expected any reaction would crop up in New York.

At the opening such gold mining shares as Alaska, Juneau, Homestake, Dome and McIntyre all moved ahead a bit. But before the session ended McIntyre slipped into the loss column and Homestake wound up unchanged from its previous close.

Howe Sound, which is a gold and copper operation, moved up 1/2 at 8 1/2.

Soybean Price Jumps Slightly

CHICAGO, Oct. 8.—(AP)—Demand came into soybeans late in the session on the part of traders today, lifting that commodity a couple of cents and helping the rest of the market recover early losses. Only lard failed to join in the late rally.

Wheat closed 1/4 higher, corn 1/4 lower to 3/4 higher, oats unchanged to 3/4 higher, rye (new style) unchanged to 1/2 higher, soybeans 2 to 2 1/2 higher and lard 1/2 to 60 cents a hundred pounds lower.

The agriculture department announced the November schedule calls for export of about 44,000,000 bushels of wheat and rye, which undoubtedly will be mostly wheat. Major recipients will be India, West Germany, Egypt and Brazil. In addition, about 19,000,000 bushels of coarse grains and oil seeds are scheduled for export.
