### WARNING—DANGEROUS RUG AHEAD

When is a good idea not a good idea? When it's good decoration but dangerous, as is the case with this rug on the stairs. Mrs. W. S. writes that she has a grandfather clock on the first landing of a stairway and is thinking of adding a braided or hooked rug in this way. But she wisely questions the idea. "How can the rug be fastened to the floor so it will be secure?" she asks. "And if it is fastened securely, won't there still be a risk of stumbling over the edges?" No matter how handsome a rug like this is, or how it's secured, Mrs. S., it's a hazard. The National Safety Council has told us so often that the largest number of accidents happen at home, and that the largest percentage of these are falls. There are bound to be times when hurried feet trip over the raised edges of a rug, and either to pitch forward onto the stairs or to fall down even so short a flight could be serious. Avoid placing rugs in dangerous places and lock into the many new ways rugs are made safer today with non-slip backs and curl-proof edges.
