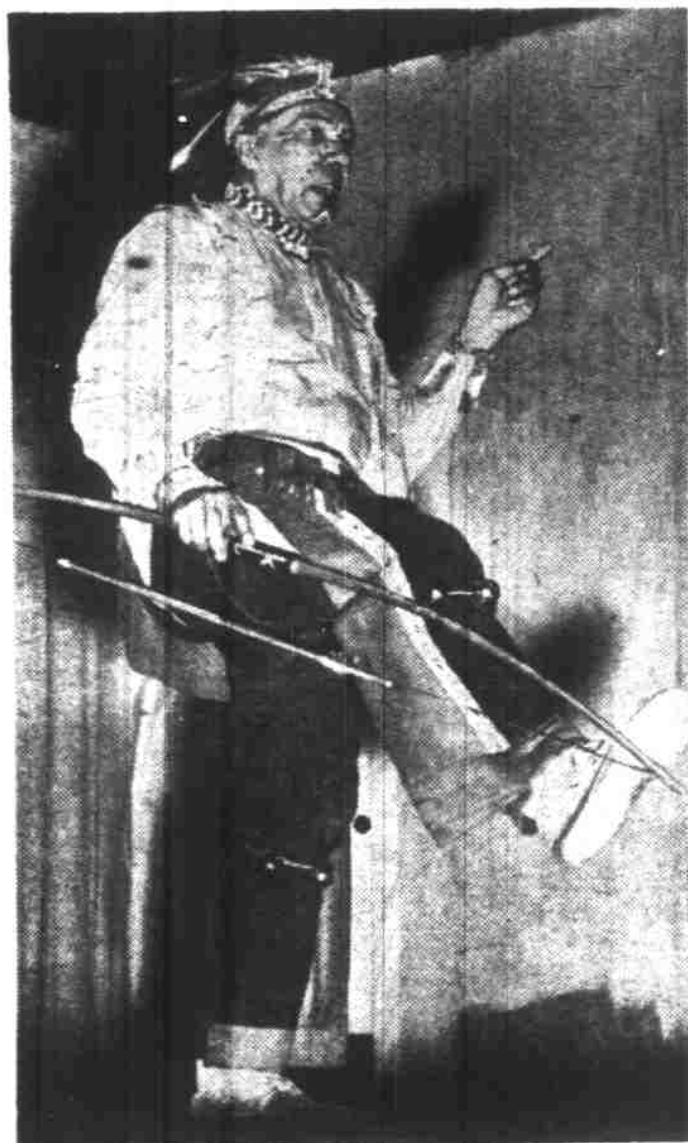
Power Firm's Rates Raised

Order adjusting the rates of the California-Oregon Power Company, to provide an annual revenue increase of \$234,893, was signed by Public Utilities Commissioner Heltzel Wednesday. The company had requested an increase of \$289,463.

Heltzel said it had become necessary for the company to construct additional power plants under high cost conditions and to acquire some electricity from outside sources.

In some classifications of service the company's rates are reduced, Heltzel said. The average increase amounts to 2 per cent, although some lumber mills have their rates doubled, he added.

PORTLAND (AP)—The recent \$1250 fine levied against Fred Meyer, Inc., here was the largest on a violation charge since the Office of Price Stabilization was set up the Portland OPS office reported Wednesday.

The fine was imposed by Federal Judge Gus Solomon March 28 on OPS charges of removing grade labels from meat and charging over-ceiling prices. Fred Meyer did not contest the charge.
