Many free attractions will follow at the stores area, including folk dancing, exhibition dance prizes and other events.

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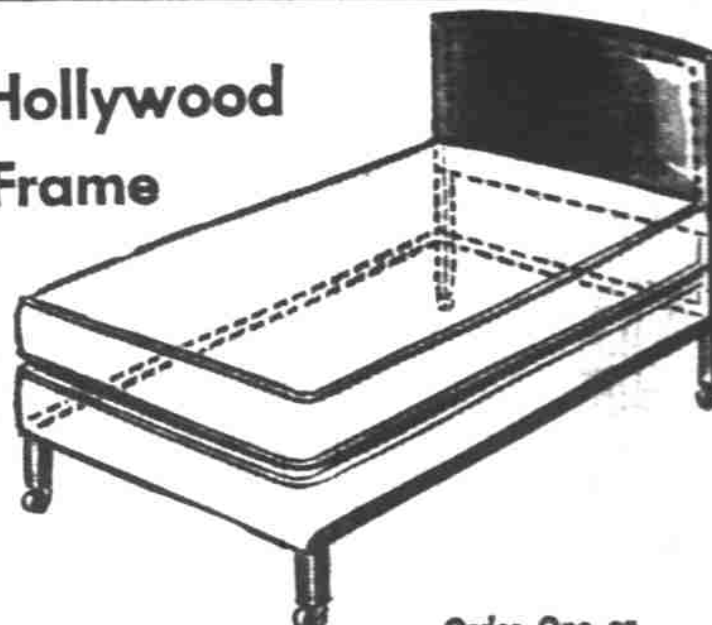
