Picnic Ware Now Has New Style, Outdoor Eating More Enjoyable

Picnic time is about here and there are many new items to make outdoor eating more enjoyable. One of the new styles carry-all containers for picnics is a creation of Petra Cabot, industrial designer. An inexpensive combination, it is made of coated steel with a vinyl finish insulated throughout with fiber glass. The container will keep four gallons of food or liquid hot or cold for a long time. It holds 300 ice cubes intact for 34 hours and can actually serve as an auxiliary refrigerator for indoor as well as outdoor parties. You can use it as a fisherman's bucket or for frozen foods. A transparent plastic separator tray can be suspended from the top to keep bottled goods and ice from sandwiches or other dry food. Plastic dishes of all kinds are an excellent investment for a family that likes to go on picnics.

New Lyons Store Opens

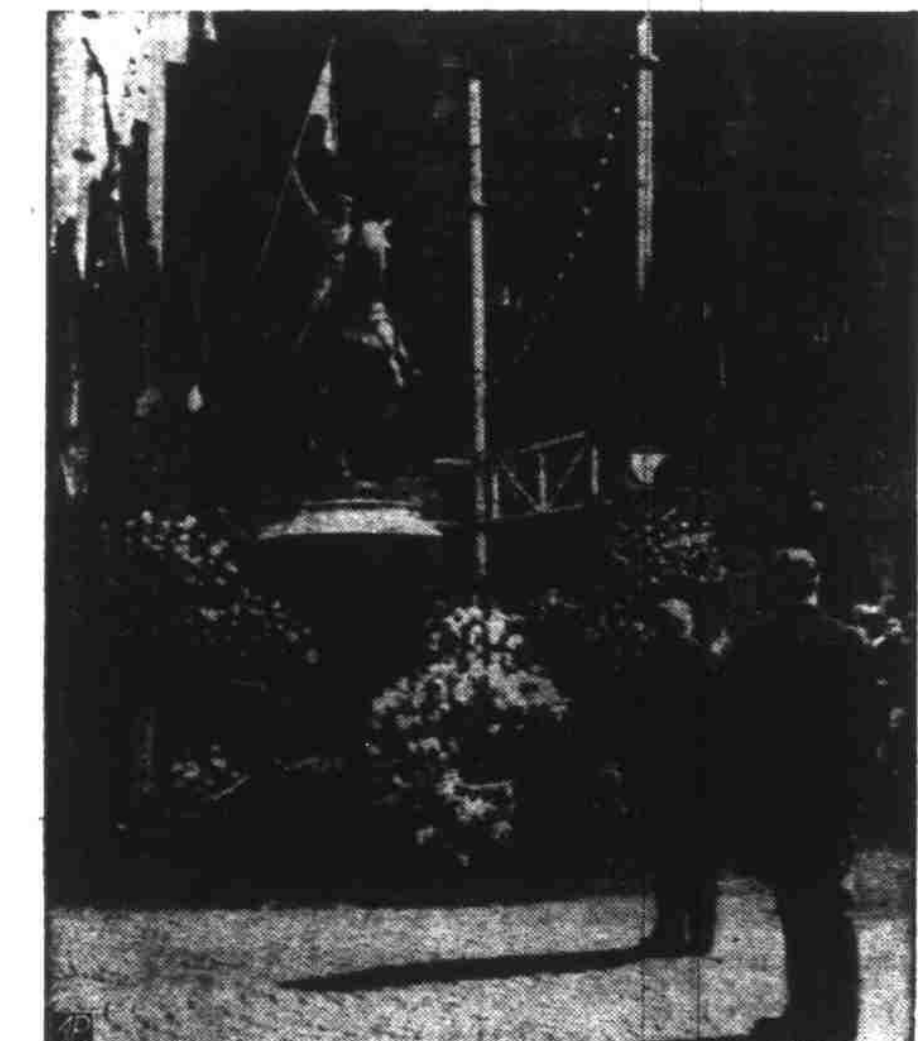

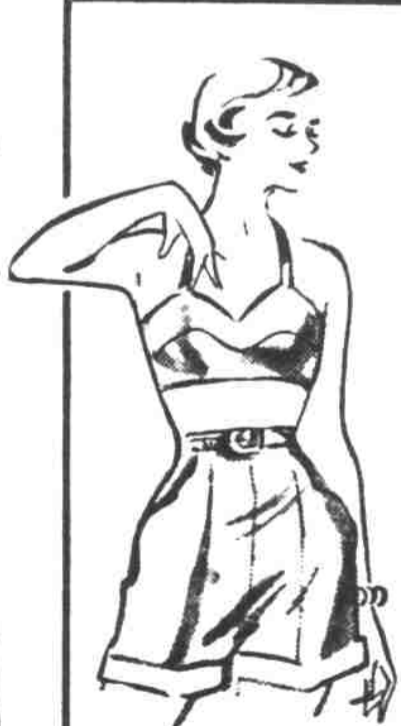
