Wheat closed $\frac{1}{4}$ lower, corn $\frac{1}{4}$ lower to $\frac{1}{2}$ higher, oats unchanged to $\frac{1}{4}$ higher, rye $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ lower, soybeans $\frac{1}{4}$ lower to $\frac{1}{2}$ higher, and lard 2 to 8 cents a hundred pounds lower.

Stocks Banish Bearish Gloom

NEW YORK (AP)—Wall Street banished its bearish gloom this week, and the stock market marched ahead to a new 22-year-high.

That led many to conclude that the traditional summer rally had started with a good bounce. This was the first five-day week of the four-month summer schedule. The average advanced \$2 on the week, the second biggest weekly gain of the year, and at the close stood at \$105.70. That was the highest it has been since June 13, 1930.
