The Christ's Ambassadors, youth organization, has a vesper service each evening at 6:30, directed by the Rev. Robert Pirtle, state youth director.

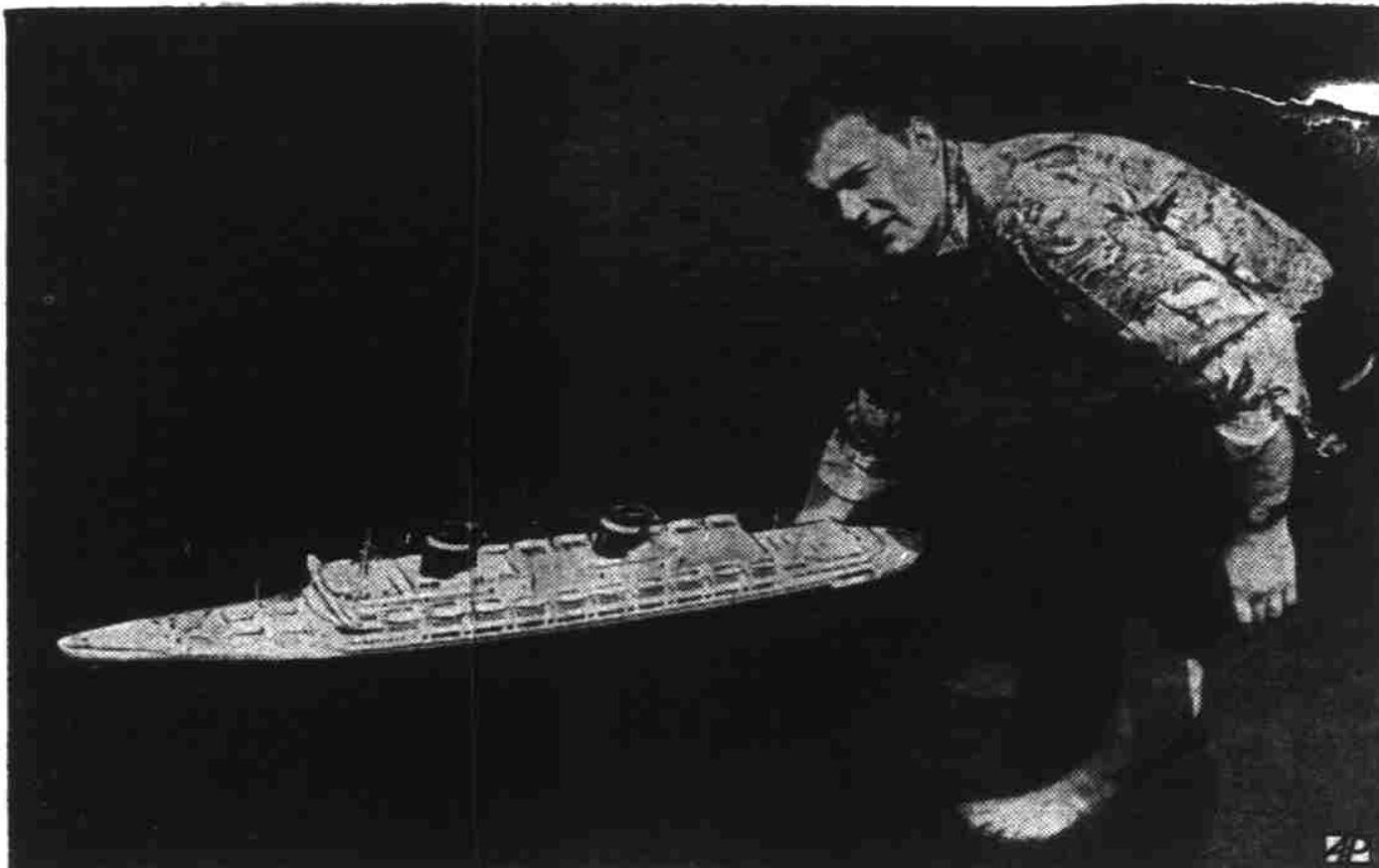
