The famous Latvian tenor, Artur Cavara, will present a program of operatic selections and Latvian songs at 7 p.m. Sunday, August 10, in the Masonic Temple at 1119 S. W. Park Ave., Portland.

Cavara studied voice in Latvia, with Berlin, Prof. Milan and New York. He sang the leading tenor parts in the Latvian National Opera in Riga, State and City Opera Houses in Berlin, State Opera House in Vienna, City Opera House in Zurich, Teatro Colon in Buenos Aires and has made appearances on stage and radio in the U.S. and Canada.

Mrs. Robert Sullivan will entertain members of her bridge club this afternoon at the W. B. Sullivan home on North Summer Street.

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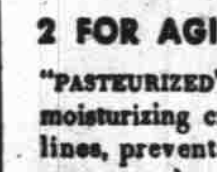
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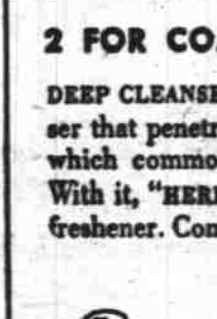
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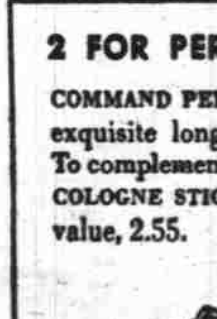
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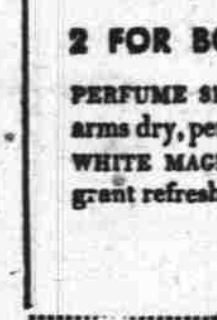
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
