

Eugene Asked To Quit River Developments

Gov. Douglas McKay's committee on natural resources has requested the Eugene Water Board to abandon its proposal for further power development on the McKenzie River.

The committee, consisting of heads of various state agencies, said the McKenzie River "is more valuable to the state of Oregon as a scenic, recreational area than as a potential power source."

The Eugene Water Board has plans to construct tunnels to direct the flow of the river to produce power.
