City, Rural Levy Drops At Willamina

WILLAMINA — Willamina property owners taxes will be less this year than last, as well as the taxes in the rural areas.

There will be an increase this year in county tax millage of 1.2 mills, one mill of which was voted recently on the bond issue for a new jail.

The Yamhill county rural school district millage for elementary purposes this year is 19.9 mills compared to 17.9 mills last year and the high school millage is 14.4 mills compared to 14.7 mills last year.

This is the millage rate for all class 2 and class 3 districts except where the individual grade or high school voted a special levy.

Taxes Go Up At Sheridan

SHERIDAN — Sheridan property owners will pay an increased tax this year and property owners outside Sheridan will also have an increase.

There will be an increase in county tax millage this year. The millage rate for the city of Sheridan will be 17.5 mills compared to 18.2 mills last year.

The consolidated levy for the city this year is 98 mills compared to 94.1 mills last year. The millage tax rate for the Sheridan school district will be 63.9 mills compared to 69.5 mills last year.
