Squire will replace Miss Mathilda Gilles of Salem. Elected to serve with Squire were Lloyd Lewis, Prineville, first vice-president; Harold Shepherd, Tillamook, second vice-president; Darrell Potter, Klamath Falls, secretary; Florence Beardsley of the State Department of Education, treasurer.

In their final business session delegates voted to sponsor projects in connection with the Cooperative Program in Education Administration under Kellogg Fund sponsorship. Such projects will be decided upon by the advisory board.

Special guests at a Monday night banquet included Mrs. Carl Booth, Marion County school superintendent; Robert Dow, Salem, state president of Classroom Teachers Association; Dr. Charles A. Howard, former superintendent of public instruction and former president of Oregon College of Education.

Speakers at the banquet were Dr. Paul Jacobson, dean of the School of Education at University of Oregon, on curricular revision, and Francis Smith of Portland on the responsibility of the State Board of Education.

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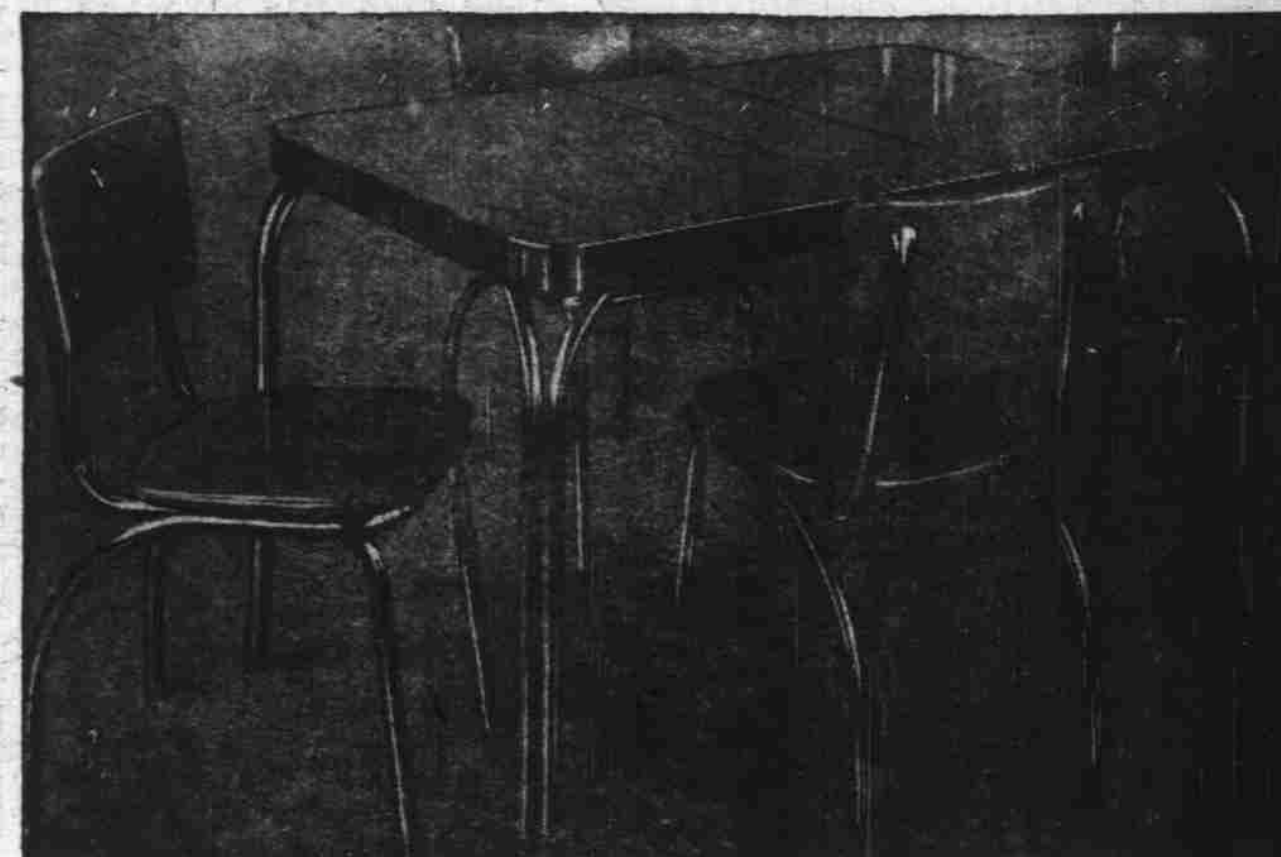
