Schuman Plan Nationsto View Constitution

PARIS (#) - The foreign ministers of the six Schuman Plan nations agreed Tuesday to meet in Rome from June 12 to July 1 to examine a draf constitution which would unify them politically. The foreign ministers also voted

to hold a council at The Hague July 10 to receive a report from Italy's premier-foreign minister, Alcide de Gasperi, on the results of the Rome conference. Italy, France, West Germany, Belgium, The Netherlands and Luxembourg make up the group. The work of the Rome meeting

will be begun by the foreign min-isters and wound up by their deputies.

Red Learned 'New Values' In Oregon

PORTLAND (?) — A deportation hearing witness said Monday that he left the Communist Party because he learned a new set of values in Oregon.

"I found that people are not all black or white, that all reactionaries are not so bad," said Walter R. P. Wilmot, New York City, testifying in the deportation case against William A. Mackie, a Portland painter.

Wilmot also testified that as a Communist he helped organize the Portland chapter of the American Newspaper Guild in 1937, but charter Guild members said that was not the way they remembered

They said he might have taken part in an early, unsuccessful attempt to sign up members. They said the Portland chapter actually was organized in 1941. They could not recall Wilmot's name in connection with any Guild activity.

Wilmot said that in 1937 he was in Portland publishing the Labor New Dealer.




