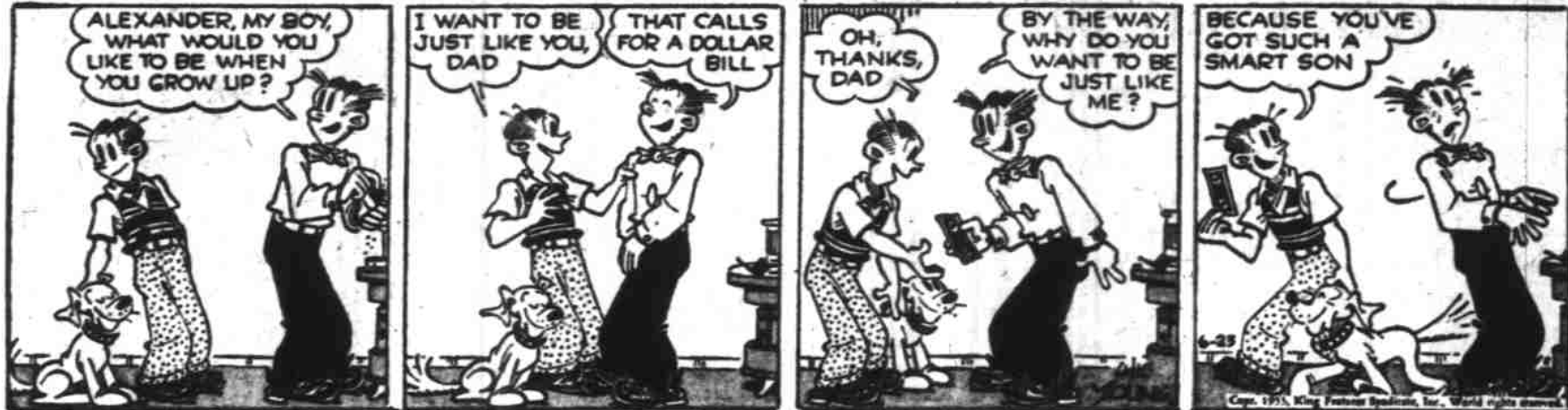

Wheat Prices Fall Again in Grain Market

CHICAGO (U.P.) — Wheat futures took another slump on the board of trade Monday, dropping more than 3 cents a bushel on selling brought about by expansion of the harvest movement.

Wheat closed 2 1/4 to 3 1/2 cents lower, corn 1/4 to 1 1/2 cents higher, oats ahead 1/4 to 1 1/2, rye unchanged to 1 cent lower, soybeans 1/2 to 3/4 higher, and lard 5 to 13 cents a hundred pounds higher.

The first car of red wheat came into the Chicago market Monday from Southern Illinois. More are reported to be on the way. The harvest is expected to expand in Southern Illinois and Indiana rapidly. Since storage space is extremely scarce in this region, much of the wheat is expected to be marketed.

Stock Market Stages Rally

NEW YORK (U.P.) — The stock market rose Monday in a rally led by the railroad and petroleum shares.

Profit-taking in the afternoon pared most advances, but gains of around a point were fairly common at the close. A few issues gained two points or more.

Volume totaled 1,030,000 shares — up from 890,000 on Friday, the smallest since Aug. 29, 1932.

The Associated Press average of 60 industrial stocks rose 60 cents to \$106.30. The industrial average was ahead 70 cents at \$137.50, the rail average up 70 cents at \$86 and the utility average up 10 cents at \$50.90.
