

### North Korea Shuffles Red Party Chiefs

TOKYO (AP)—The Pyongyang radio announced Tuesday night a drastic shakeup of the North Korean Communist Party and the "suicide" of a former vice premier close on the heels of a purge of the Red regime.

A broadcast heard by Radio Press said the party's "Central Government Committee" had been dissolved and power concentrated in a five-man "Central Government Committee of the Korean Labor (Communist) Party."

Marshal Kim Il Sung, boss of Communist North Korea, heads the committee. Another member is Gen. Nam Il, the North Korean who headed the Communist armistice negotiating team. He became foreign minister in the recent government shakeup.

Pyongyang said Pak Chong Ai, only woman member of the Central Government Committee, announced at the Central Committee meeting the "suicide" of deposed Vice Minister Hu Ka I. His name was given by South Korean sources as Hu Ka Week, supposedly a Russian-trained Korean who was one of Marshal Kim's arch rivals.

Pak said that "the crimes of Hu Ka I, who committed suicide in rebellion against the party, the government and the people, must be exposed and prosecuted."

### 150 Idled by Portland Tieup

PORTLAND (AP)—Eighty machinists and 70 other workmen were idled here Tuesday by a strike against the Freightliner Corp. and the Factory Motor Car Co., subdivisions of Consolidated Freightways.

The AFL Machinists Union called the strike to support demands for a 12-cent hourly wage increase. The Portland Central Labor Council authorized the walkout. The struck firm assembles freight trucks and trailers.

### Paper Credits Ike's Success

WASHINGTON (AP)—The "Democratic Digest" said Tuesday Democratic cooperation with President Eisenhower so far has made "all the difference between success and failure for his administration."

A leading article in the September issue of the Democratic national committee's official publication — second since adoption of a pocket-size magazine format — sums up the actions of the first session of the 83rd Congress under the title, "How Democrats Saved Ike From His Own Party."

It says the President's "real enemies are within his own party, and his efforts to placate the implacable Republicans have placed him in some unfortunate situations." It goes on to say:

"He apparently does not feel that he can afford to acknowledge the timely assistance he receives from Democrats, even though that cooperation makes all the difference between success and failure for his administration."

"At times he seems to feel that he must appear to be giving the opposition a scorching in a manner that the Old Guard will approve."

### Man Jailed as Check Passer

PORTLAND (AP)—A man wanted for passing bad checks in Salem, Portland and Eugene has been arrested in Eureka, Calif., Detective Chief William D. Browne said here Tuesday.

Browne, who identified him as Roy Arthur Nelson, 35, said Portland police also want to question him about burglaries here three months ago.

Browne said Nelson, when arrested, is reported to have had a car he rented in Eugene last May. Browne added that a warrant charging him with larceny was filed in Eugene after he left that city.

### 3 Salem Women Admitted to U. O. Nursing Course

Three Salem women, Norma Rae Hamilton, Joan Marie Miller and Margaret Miller, have been admitted to the University of Oregon Medical School department of nursing, the school's admissions committee said Wednesday.

Miss Hamilton and Miss Joan Marie Miller studied pre-nursing at the University of Oregon, and Miss Margaret Miller attended Oregon State College.

They will enter nurse's training in September in the class of 1956.

### Knock on Wood


