Woodburn Adopts New System of Fire-siren Blasts

WOODBURN—A new fire-alarm system is in operation for the Woodburn rural and city areas, according to Floyd Maricle, fire chief.

Hereafter, one blast on the siren truck will be sent to Gervais or out on a grass or chimney fire requiring only a few firemen.

Three blasts will indicate a fire involving a house, barn or building requiring all members of the fire department.

The old system of one blast indicating a fire outside of Woodburn and two for a fire within the city limits has been discontinued. The new signals are designed to conserve manpower by not calling out all firemen on all calls.
