County Birth Totals Far Above Deaths

BIRTHS in Marion County during October totaled 282 compared to 93 deaths for the same period, according to a report from the Marion County Department of Health.

Of the births, 135 were male and 147 female, the report continued. Male deaths numbered 51 compared to 42 female deaths.

Heart disease accounted for 42 deaths and cancer was the second largest killer with 17 to its credit.

In the reportable and communicable disease report, 33 cases of measles were reported during October compared to three cases for October 1952. Eleven cases of ringworm were also reported for October 1953.

A member of the board of trustees said the explosion occurred in the gas heated boiler in the basement.
