# Donald Church Slates Revival

DONALD—The Church of the Nazarene here will hold evangelistic services starting Sunday morning and continuing seven days.

The following groups will be featured during the week: Monday, ladies' night; Tuesday, men's night; Wednesday, children's night; Thursday, family night; and Friday, teenage night. A Thanksgiving service will be held Thursday at 10 a.m.

A Bible Conference, conducted by an internationally noted biblical scholar, will get underway at the First Presbyterian Church Sunday and will continue through Friday.

Conducting the conference will be Dr. John W. Bowman, professor of New Testament interpretation at the San Francisco Theological Seminary. He will lecture on the Book of Revelation at 10 a.m. each day except Thursday and at 7:30 each evening on the "Word of God and Conversion."

Before accepting his present position, Dr. Bowman taught in the Union Theological College at Saharampur, North India; Western Theological Seminary at Pittsburgh, Pa.; and St. Mary's College of the University of St. Andrews, Scotland.

Teaching in three languages, Greek, Hindustani and English, Dr. Bowman's New Testament courses include historical and literary interpretation of Biblical theology. He was editor's consultant on the Revised Standard Version of the Bible and was one of the editors of the Westminster Study Edition of the Bible.

An author in his own right, Dr. Bowman has published several books, the latest being "The Religion of Maturity."

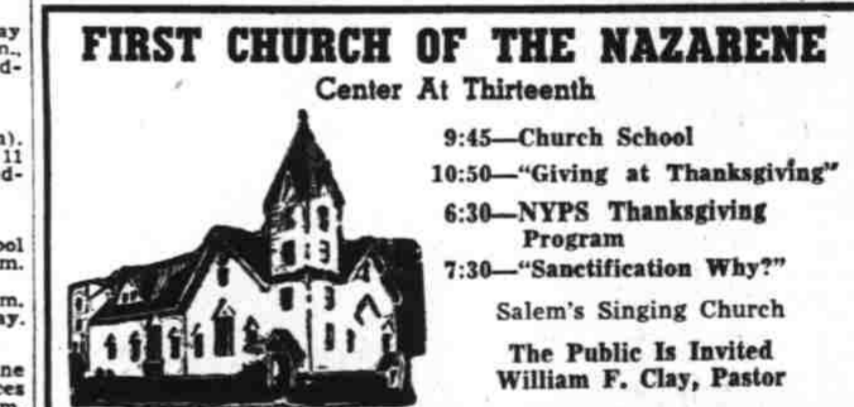
