

# Editors Had Freedom on Tour of Russia

 BERLIN (AP) — Homeward bound after a three-week visit to the Soviet Union, seven American college editors said Tuesday the Russians greeted them warmly, put them up in the best hotels and gave them complete freedom of movement on tours.  
 But the group occasionally ran into trouble over photography. They told newsmen upon their arrival from Moscow they noted that anti-American propaganda there was directed against the U.S. government and what the Russians called "top capitalists" rather than against the American people.  
 "Our most outstanding impression was that we were so warmly greeted," said Richard E. Ward, managing editor of the University of Chicago Maroon. "Being Americans, we wondered what kind of a greeting we would get."  
 During two weeks they split into two parties and toured parts of the Soviet Union. Ward said they received "absolutely complete freedom of movement" on the tours, but sometimes had difficulty over their camera work. They were asked by the Russians not to take pictures of harbors, factories and industrial areas.  
 Dave Barney of the Reed Quest, Reed College, Portland, Ore., said they encountered considerable feeling among Russian university students against Sen. Joseph McCarthy (R-Wis.).  
 The editors were reluctant to tell the full details of their experiences, saying they had promised to write about them for various newspapers on their return home.  
 The party left by plane late Tuesday for Frankfurt and planned to proceed to Paris Tuesday night by train. They are scheduled to leave Paris Wednesday by plane and arrive in New York Thursday.

# Father of 3 Charged With Bank Robbery

BUTTE, Mont. (AP) — An Idaho Falls father of three small children Tuesday was charged with robbery in the \$14,000 Victor, Mont., bank robbery Christmas Eve.

The complaint against Roland Lynn Wilson, 20, Idaho Falls, Idaho, was filed with U. S. Commissioner David F. Holland in Butte. Holland said he has recommended bond of \$10,000.

Percy Wylly, in charge of the Montana-Idaho FBI Division, announced Wilson's arrest at Idaho Falls Tuesday.  
 Wylly said Wilson was being returned to Victor to show where he allegedly buried the money in the Rocky Mountain Bitterroot Valley. Wylly quoted Wilson as saying he staged the holdup alone and had spent only \$340 before catching the loot.

The bank was robbed by a lone man wearing a cowboy outfit and colored glasses.  
 Wilson was quoted as saying he was visiting a relative near Victor when he robbed the bank and fled into the mountains. Later, he returned to the relative's ranch in the same car used for the getaway. No preliminary hearing date will be set until Wilson is brought before Holland.

# Gen. MacArthur Defends Use of Minesweepers

NEW YORK (AP) — Gen. Douglas MacArthur Tuesday disputed a Japanese report that he used Japanese minesweepers in a violation of international law in a war landing operation by American Marines at Wonsan, Korea, in 1950.  
 He said the minesweepers had been used since the end of World War II to clear suspected old Japanese mines from Wonsan and other areas and that they were not involved in any belligerence.  
 The former Far East commander said there was no violation of either international or Japanese law.

The Japanese newspaper Sangyo Keizai had quoted Sanji Oku, former commander of Japan's Coast Guard, as saying use of the vessels constituted violation of international law.

# 3,000 Japanese To Move to Brazil

TOKYO (AP) — Japan plans to send 600 families, about 3,000 persons, to Brazil this year although Brazil has offered to accept 5,000 families, Kyodo News Service said Wednesday.

Japanese officials said budgetary and other factors will limit the flow of settlers from Japan, and they also thought it wiser to limit the number to 600 families yearly to insure successful settlement.
