

Pilot, Woman Doctor on Dog Sled Save Trio

FAIRBANKS, Alaska (AP)—A woman doctor on a dog sled and a bush pilot flying in 46 degrees below zero weather teamed Wednesday in a dramatic rescue of three persons badly injured in a plane crash on Yukon River ice.

Frank "Tuffy" Edgington, his wife, Rosalind, and a friend, Lottie Justin, a 55-year-old native woman, had crashed at the Yukon River village of Kalland while trying to land on the ice two days ago.

Both women were painfully cut and bruised. The pilot was injured critically.

"Tuffy" was unconscious, and delirious while the two women spent an hour and a half pulling him from the wreckage to a log cabin on the river bank.

Then the injured native woman walked three miles to the cabin of John Swenson.

Swenson raced his dogs 30 miles in four hours to pick up Dr. Jean Persons at Tanana and take her to the scene in six hours of sub-zero darkness.

A call from Tanana brought a bush pilot, Bob Byers, from Fairbanks with a plane. He landed by the light from two flaming cans of gasoline, two hours before the doctor's midnight arrival by dog team.

The pilot flew the two injured women to a Tanana hospital, then returned and flew Edgington and Dr. Persons to a Fairbanks hospital.

The injured man was reported in critical condition.

Rich Widow Adopts Boys In California

MARYSVILLE, Calif. (AP)—Mrs. Muriel McCormick Hubbard, 51, widow of a Rockefeller, adopted two boys Tuesday in Yuba County Superior Court.

The fact of the double adoption was learned Wednesday, but details, including the names and background of the boys, were kept secret under California law.

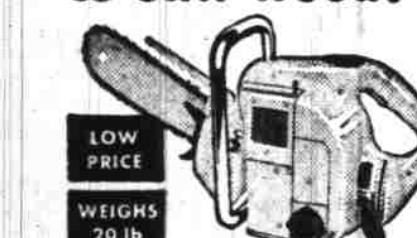
Mrs. Hubbard refused to see newsmen at her modest Marysville home, which she purchased during World War II service with the Women's Army Corps at nearby Camp Beale. Her attorney, Ray Manwell, said "there will be no release, no pictures, no statement—nothing."

Superior Judge Arthur Coats of Sutter County, who presided over the adoption hearing, declined to discuss any details, saying "adoption proceedings are closed proceedings." Records of the adoption were sealed in the county vault and County Clerk Adrienne Conley said they would not be made public.

This was in line with state law designed to protect adopted children and their new parents from embarrassment.

The word "coin" originally meant the wedge-shaped die used for stamping coins but was later transferred to the piece of metal money so stamped.

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Married Least Likely To Commit Suicide

OMAHA (AP)—Married people in this area are the least likely to commit suicide. Widows, widowers and divorced persons head the list. Single persons are next.

A study by Florence Izenstat, sociology student at the University of Omaha shows more than half the 1,009 suicides in 22 years were recorded during the depression years, 1931 to 1938. Aged persons were the most likely to take their own lives. Most of the self-inflicted deaths were among those in the middle and upper-income brackets.

Fire Hoses Halt Mexico Labor Rush

CALEXICO, Calif. (AP)—Streams from fire hoses halted an attempt by more than 1,000 Mexican laborers to storm across the border into the United States Wednesday.

The hoses were manned by Mexican firemen, called out by Mexican police to help stem the stampede. A few laborers were trampled but there were no reports of serious injury.

Participants were loaded into patrol cars and taken to the Mexican jail, just across the border. Meantime, 500 laborers were admitted across the border for farm jobs in the Imperial Valley. This brings to 2,800 the number of Mexicans admitted for the jobs in the past six days.

United States border gates were closed after Wednesday's quota came through. More Mexicans will be admitted Thursday.

The laborers are being recruited under a new policy adopted by the United States after negotiations for a new American-Mexican farm labor contract broke down last Dec. 31. The Mexican government is opposed to the recruitment until a contract is signed.

Geographical Liquor Problem to Policemen

GREENVILLE, S.C. (AP)—Police have confiscated liquor from the same spot 22 times in a year—no arrests.

The spot is in a vacant city area, close enough to be within handy reach of nearby houses when customers arrive, but not close enough to connect the contraband booze with anyone.



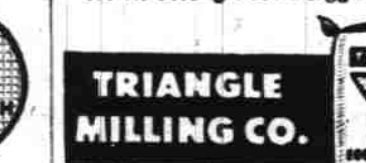
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Firemen Supply Breakfasts for 2

ROXBORO, N. C. (AP)—Roxboro's volunteers firemen didn't have their fish fry. They changed their plans after hearing that two sisters, 11 and 13, told schoolmates that they got hardly anything to eat except the free lunch-

es at the cafeteria on school days. Welfare department workers reported that eight in that family were living on \$60 a month from the agency.

The firemen voted to use their party money to buy breakfasts for the girls for 40 days.

TAX AUDIT ORDERED
LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (AP)—An audit for every business in the state collecting sales taxes has been ordered by Revenue Commissioner Vance Scurlock after a spot check in 12 towns. The check showed only 68 per cent of the firms were collecting the full tax and that 5 per cent were collecting no tax.

Average New Yorker Found Most Friendly
GLASGOW, Scotland (AP)—A Scottish journalist who visited America found the average New Yorker "the friendliest man in the world. Polite, hopeful, hospitable," Thomas Olsen summed up in the Glasgow Daily Record. Olsen said the European idea

of the "pugnacious American" originated in the days "when America was struggling to assert herself in world affairs."
