

Magazine Mail Rates Attacked By McCarthy

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. McCarthy (R-Wis.) asked Postmaster General Summerfield Tuesday to look into the possibility of recapturing from profitable magazines "some of the subsidy" they receive in mail rates.

McCarthy advanced the suggestion while presiding over the start of a Senate appropriations subcommittee's hearings on the money requests of the Post Office Department for the new fiscal year starting July 1.

Referring repeatedly to Time and Life, magazines published by Henry R. Luce, the senator said he was "trying to think of one reason" why magazines which make huge profits should have "government subsidized" mail rates.

He requested Summerfield to direct his legal staff to check into the possibility of having the government recover some of the mail "subsidy" paid to magazines whose books show at the end of a year that they have made a substantial profit.

Summerfield promised to have his staff do so immediately. He noted that second class mail rates, covering magazines and newspapers, are set by Congress and said there is no authority under present law for the renegotiation procedure proposed by McCarthy.

Duke Freed On Charges Of Contempt

WASHINGTON (AP) — Russell W. Duke, accused by Senate investigators of having been an "influence peddler" specializing in West Coast tax cases, was acquitted in federal court Tuesday of a charge of contempt of Congress.

U. S. District Judge Burnita S. Matthews ruled that Duke had not refused to honor a subpoena summoning him before the Senate investigations subcommittee headed by Sen. McCarthy (R-Wis.).

McCarthy promptly ordered a new subpoena served on Duke and announced the investigation into his activities would be reopened. McCarthy's group had complained that Duke, a former public relations specialist, did not show up for questioning last spring about reports that he made \$34,000 peddling "influence" over a 2½ year period.

But Judge Matthews, granting a defense motion for judgment of acquittal, said the evidence showed that Duke had been released from any obligation to appear before the subcommittee.

"The government failed to establish the essential elements of the offense charged (contempt of Congress)," the court ruled.

7 Pneumonia Cases Listed

Seven cases of pneumonia were reported in Salem and the rest of Marion County for the week Jan. 16-23 according to a report from the county health department.

Other diseases reported for this period in Salem were one case of hepatitis (disease of the liver), one case of measles, two mumps and one venereal disease.

Diseases in the rest of the county during this period included one erysipelas (skin disease), one hepatitis, one influenza, three measles, four mumps, one ringworm, two scarlet fever and two venereal disease. One case of tuberculosis and one of venereal disease were reported in state institutions.

College Editor Says Russians Appear Healthy
