trading with a gain of 21/2 at 251/4 with business in that one stock amounting to nearly 111/2 per cent of all of the trading done on the New York stock exchange Friday. Portland Produce The Associated Press average of

60 stocks advanced 40 cents to a new recovery high of \$114.90, only \$1.40 under the 1953-54 peak established in early January of last year. That top in turn is the highest since mid-1930.

The average was boosted by a gain of 80 cents in the industrial component, 30 cents in railroads and 10 cents in utilities. Both the industrial and utility components of the average were at new highs 93 score, 66 1/2 lb; 92 score, 65 1/2; for 1953-54.

The market was a narrow af: fair with only 1,097 individual issues traded, the least in the past month. There were 472 gainers and 312 losers in the list with 44 new highs and 1 new low for 1953-54. Volume amounted to 1,730,000 shares as compared with 1,860,000 shares traded Thursday.


